

### Quebec Areas Seen Likely Historic Sites

QUEBEC (CP)—Whole areas of Old Quebec are on the road to being declared an historic site.

A notice has been published in the Quebec official Gazette advising that the Historic Monuments Commission has declared the city declared an historic site.

The site includes all the land within the walls of Upper Town Quebec and large areas in Lower Town dating back to the earliest times of the French regime.

The commission was making its first use of legislation approved during the last legislative session.

Under the law, whole areas may be declared historic sites by the cabinet on the recommendation of the Historic Monuments Commission. One month notice must be given before the cabinet may act on the suggestion.

Once an area becomes an historic site, no changes may be made to existing buildings and no new ones started without the permission of the commission. At the same time, the cabinet may issue regulations about commercial signs and posters within the area.

### School Charges In B.C. Spark Controversy

NANAIMO, B.C. (CP) — A storm of controversy has blown up over charges by a lawyer that school pupils were being brainwashed by socialist teachers in a gigantic conspiracy to take over the whole school system in British Columbia.

The charges were levelled by Harold Hine, brother-in-law of Leslie Peterson, Social Credit education minister.

Aliming his remarks at the New Democratic Party, Mr. Hine said in an interview here that not only are socialist teachers brainwashing school pupils, but the whole plan was part of a conspiracy to take over teaching in schools and to take over the school boards.

He said socialists are being trained as teachers with the aim of allowing them to get at the minds of children. Socialists in charge of school boards would act as a buffer between complaining parents and teachers.

Mr. Hine made the brainwashing charge first in a speech at a Social Credit meeting earlier in the week.

The British Columbia Teachers' Federation replied that Mr. Hine had produced no right to make "wild statements" without backing them up.

Robert Strachan, British Columbia leader of the New Democratic Party, said Mr. Hine's charges were "wild" political statements.

"He may be speaking for the minister of education."

Mr. Peterson told reporters that a teacher is "not entitled to indoctrinate children in his charge with his own political philosophies within the classroom."

### Vehicle Output Shows Increase

OTTAWA (CP) — Canadian production of passenger cars and commercial vehicles rose 28.2 per cent in September to 38,583 units from 30,107 in the same month last year, the bureau of statistics has reported.

This brought production in the first nine months of the year to 433,621 units, up 22 per cent from 355,602 a year previous. Production also was ahead of last year in all earlier months of the year.

Output of passenger cars increased 27.5 per cent in the month to 31,657 units from 24,869 in September, 1962, and 22 per cent in the January-September period to 362,415 units from 297,165.

Commercial vehicle production rose 31 per cent in the month to 7,326 units from 5,747 and 22.2 per cent in the nine months to 71,496 units from 58,437.

### One Woman Wins Of Four Running

HALIFAX (CP)—Three of the four women candidates in Tuesday's Nova Scotia election went down to defeat.

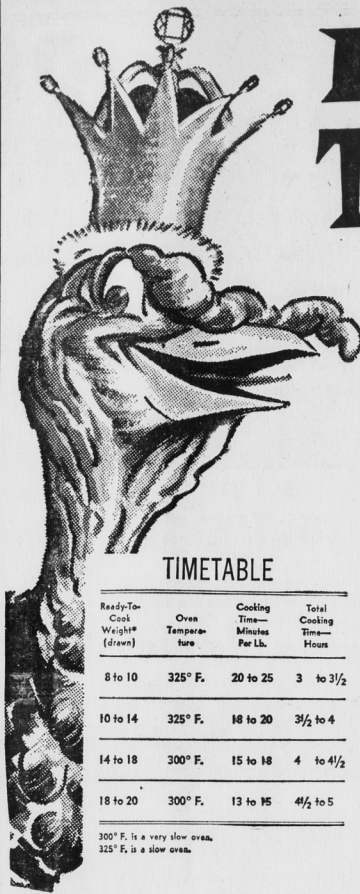
Mrs. Gladys Porter, a Progressive Conservative, was elected to her second term in Kings North, the only woman among the victorious candidates.
