Belgians Probe Alcohol Racket

BRUSSELS (Reuters) - Police raided a secret still and arrested three men at Malines, near here, as a nation wide investigation continued Sunday into an alcohol racket blamed for the death of nine persons.

Bottles of liquor and liqueur chocolates, suspected of containing poisonous wood alcohol, were cleared out of shops and bars across Belgium.

Twelve Belgians have been arrested in Antwerp on charges of illegal possession of adulterated alcohol.

They are suspected of having sold large quantities of wood alcohol under well-known spirits labels to unsuspecting firms all over the country.

Want UN To Call Halt To Bomb Testing UNITED NATIONS (CP) - India and Russia have made separate formal proposals that the United Nations assembly call for an immediate halt to nuclear weapons tests.

They submitted resolutions to the UN secretary Saturday night. The proposals were made public Sunday.

They will be considered first in the assembly's political committee. The committee starts work Wednesday. It may complete its disarmament debate before the Soviet Union, the United States and Britain begin talks in Geneva Oct. 31 for an agreement to end nuclear testing.

The Indian resolution would have the assembly call for immediate suspension of the testing of atomic and hydrogen weapons pending an agreement at Geneva. The Soviet resolution proposes that the assembly say it "calls upon all states carrying out tests of atomic and hydrogen weapons to discontinue such test immediately."

SEASICKNESS PILLS TESTED PORTSMOUTH, Eng. (Reuters) - The Royal Navy used everything in the book Monday to make a group of 90 volunteers suffer from the one thing seamen never talk about - seasickness.

The volunteers, all from the army, will take part in a series of tests to find a pill that can be given to amphibious troops to prevent seasickness.

For the next two weeks they will spend an hour every other day - after "a standard and fairly substantial meal" - tossing and corking on rubber rafts being battered about in a test tank.
