Car Companies Watch Safety
 WASHINGTON (AP)—The four major U.S. automobile manufacturers have informed the Senate commerce committee of tightening procedures for notifying car owners of defects requiring correction.
 Letters from executives of General Motors, Ford, Chrysler and American Motors outlined plans for greater use of notifying owners directly by mail rather than relying on dealers, especially when safety is involved.

Family Planning Assistance Seen Best As Private Effort

OTTAWA (CP)—Family planning assistance for developing countries would have to come from private agencies rather than the federal government, H. O. Moran, director general of the Canadian foreign aid program, said Thursday.
 Under questioning by the Commons external affairs committee, Mr. Moran said the most serious single problem in developing countries is population growth.
 However, even if a family planning program was introduced in India, for example, it would take a generation to have any effect.
 As far as the Canadian foreign aid program is concerned, family planning assistance in future years would have to come from private organizations. Mr. Moran termed the whole birth control question "a delicate area."
 Mr. Moran said a "disturbing thing" in Pakistan and other areas with fast-growing populations is the deterioration of agriculture.
 Some developing countries that formerly exported food now have to import it because of the state of their agriculture.
 Mr. Moran said this would be a "useful" project for some groups. He also noted that the annual population increase of India is half that of the total population of Canada—20,000,000 people.
 In an opening brief to the committee, Mr. Moran said the current food emergency in several countries has resulted in part from drought. But "a ma-

India Restoring Pakistani Trade

NEW DELHI (AP)—The Indian government Thursday announced it is moving unilaterally to restore trade relations with Pakistan.
 A government spokesman pointed out ministerial level talks between the two countries, subsequent to the Tashkent peace declaration signed last January, didn't succeed in normalizing trade relations.
 The spokesman said normal import-export control will apply to trade with Pakistan.
