

A job well done

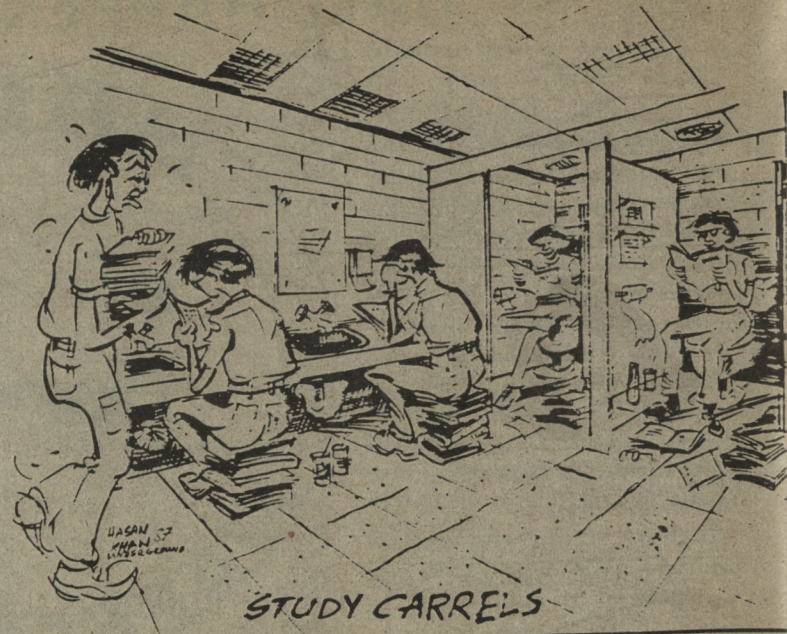

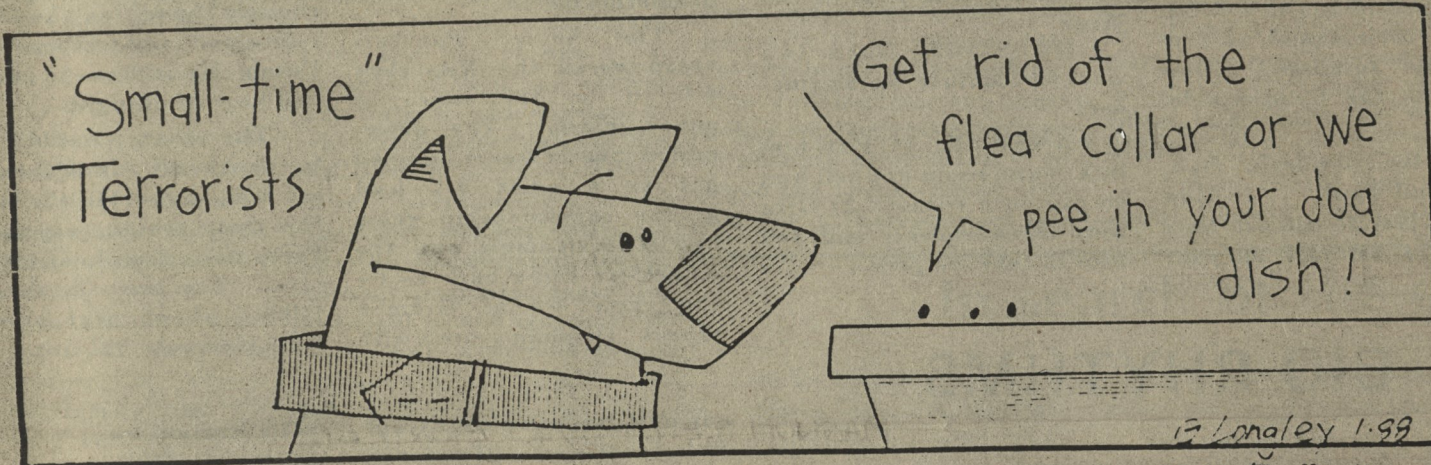
well(?????). Once again, a job well done to those involved in helping the UPEI Intramural Hockey League get recognized!

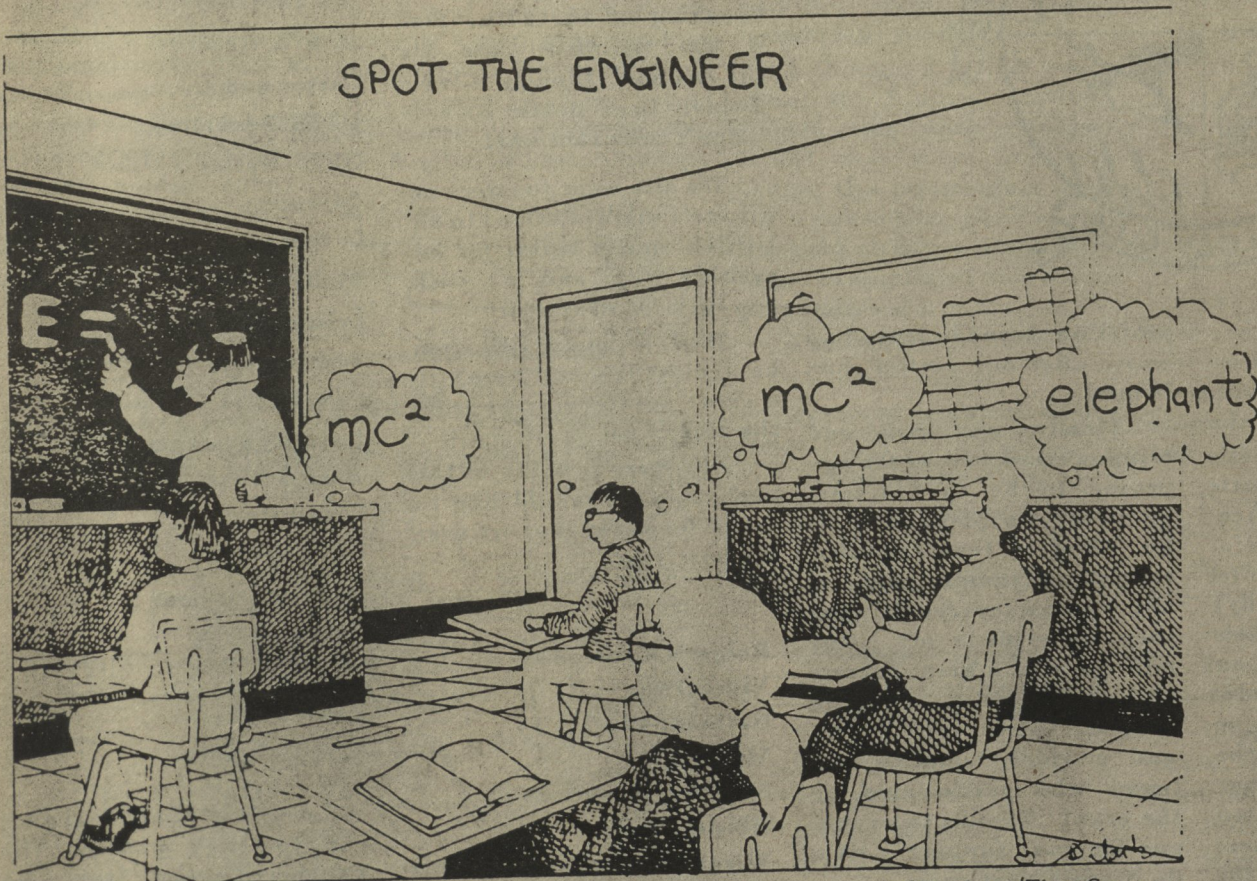
