Britain Supports Efforts To Control Outer Space Objects

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (CP)—Britain threw her support Monday behind proposals to bring talks on control of outer space objects without waiting for an over-all agreement on partial disarmament.

Minister of State Allan Noble gave Britain's endorsement in a speech before the UN political committee. He also declared Britain's unwillingness to "gamble" her security by agreeing to an unconditional suspension of tests of nuclear weapons. The British spokesman accused the Soviet Union of cynicism in "contemptuously dismissing" Western disarmament proposals.

Noble spoke in behalf of a 23-power resolution calling on the UN to endorse in principle the Western disarmament proposals, including joint study of an inspection system designed to guarantee that objects sent through outer space are used for peaceful purposes. Canada is one of the sponsoring countries. U.S. Ambassador Henry Cabot Lodge told the UN last week the

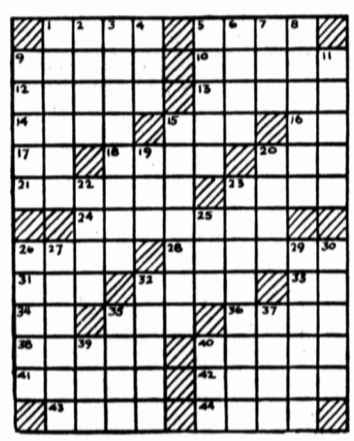
