Notes By The Way

Premier Mackenzie King has been made a member of the Imperial Privy Council and from that fact is entitled to be addressed as "Right Honourable."

It will be seen from what is above stated that in appointing Premier King to the Privy Council the Imperial Government was only following the precedent set a quarter of a century ago, and which in the case of Canada, the foremost overseas Dominion, could not be overlooked.

Meetings of the whole Council are rarely held, the principal occasions being at the beginning of a new reign or when the reigning sovereign announces his or her marriage.

Hon. Thos. A. Low is a member of the King Government without portfolio as Hon. Mr. Sinclair of Prince Edward Island is, although the Ontario Minister appears to be the less reticent of the two.

"In the province of Ontario," he said "I believe that the farmers, just the same as the urban portion of the population, if left to themselves, would appreciate the value of a tariff. Why? Because they know that the best market they have is the home market, and I can not understand how men argue from an opposite standpoint."

IT DOES NOT PAY

DAINGEROUS LIGHTS
