THE CORONATION'S SIGNIFICANCE
The ancient and venerable John
of Gaunt, in Shakespeare's Richard
II, meditates affectionately on his
country:
This royal throne of kings, this
scepter'd isle,
This precious stone set in the silver
sea,

At the moment his words have
a new life and a renewed meaning
as the eyes of the world turn upon
this tiny island. For the Queen is
to be crowned amidst all the splen-
dor and spectacle that centuries of
history can muster.
The preparation, the planning,
the care that has led up to the
coronation is beyond calculation
and almost beyond belief. Princess
Margaret put it well when she re-
marked that everyone in England
has Coronation fever. The nation
to a man is working to make this
event the most splendid in history.

Education
"It is customary for principals
to express at ceremonies of this
kind some ideas on education gen-
erally. Today I should like to say
a word or two with respect to
two questions frequently asked
by young people who seek an edu-
cation: "How can I finance an
education?" and, "what are the
qualities which make up a good
education?"

Financial Assistance
"It has been found, however, that
financial assistance can be over-
done. It is not a hand-out; it is
an award for work and an invest-
ment in the young person's future.
The recipient of such assistance is
entitled, not to a free education,
but to the opportunity of getting
an education himself. If he doesn't
make use of the opportunity he will
lose it to someone else who will.
Many of our young people are tak-
ing advantage of this help and en-
couragement which they have earn-
ed by their ability to work for it.
