TORONTO (CP) - The stock market held on to most of the gains it knocked up in the early hours Tuesday and at its close was mixed in moderate trading.

Senior base metals saw token gains with Hollinger, Hudson Bay and McIntyre among the winners. International Nickel, Gunnar and Noranda eased fractionally. Low-priced issues were mixed. Brunswick climbed 25 cents at \$5.25 an Campbell Chib 20 cents at \$5.80 but gains and losses were not prominent.

MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) - Prices were irregularly mixed Tuesday at the close of moderate trading on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges.

Trans-Mountain Pipeline fell 5 to a new low of 62. Bank of Nova Scotia dropped 1 1/2 to 51 1/2, a new low. Other new lows were registered by B.C. Power at 36, Interprovincial Pipeline at 40, McCall Oil at 53 and Dominion Foundry at 25, all down one point each.

Losses of 1/2 each were shown by Abitibi at 27 1/2, Price Brothers at 43 and Noranda at 38 1/2.

On October 7th in Queen's County Magistrate's Court the preliminary hearing of a woman charged with forgery was adjourned until the 21st.

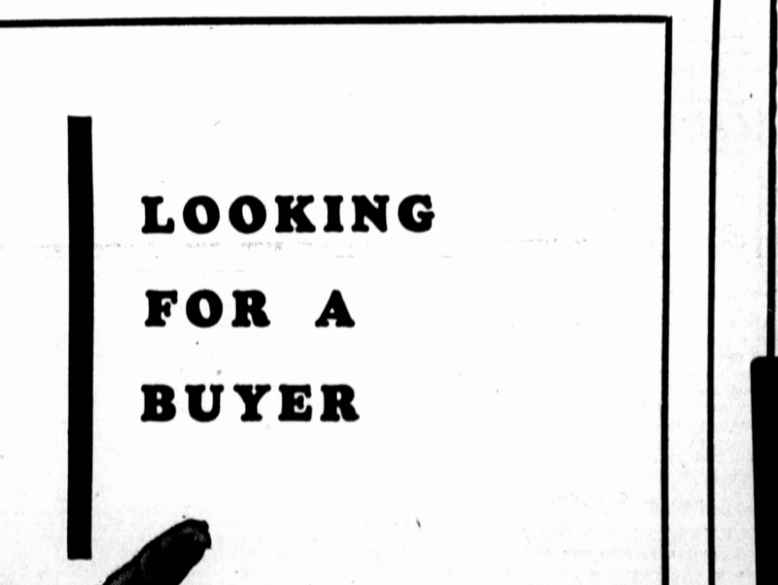
On Wednesday, October 9th, eleven cases were brought before Magistrate Gilbert A. Gaudet in the same Court.
