CHICAGO (AP) - Chicago Black Hawks scored three times in the first period and made the goals stand up the rest of the way to beat the hard-driving Detroit Red Wings 3-2 Sunday night.

The victory, the Hawks' second in two nights over the Wings, moved them into first place in the National Hockey League, one point ahead of Montreal Canadiens, who were idle.

Two goals by defenceman Pierre Pilote and a marker by rookie Dennis Hull gave the Hawks a 3-0 first-period lead. The Wings, who held an edge in the play for the final 40 minutes, bounced back with power-play tallies in the second period by Ron Murphy and Gordie Howe.
