Driver Fined On Impaired Charge

Pleading not guilty to drunken driving but guilty to the lesser count of driving while impaired by alcohol, James Nelson, Charlottetown, was fined \$25 and costs or 30 days by Magistrate A.J. Haslam, QC, in city police court yesterday.

Frank Harley, Jr., Charlottetown, charged with assault, was remanded to Dec. 30 without bail.

George Wendell Ford, Charlottetown, charged with the care and control of a motor vehicle while intoxicated, was remanded until this morning with bail to stand.

Donald James Gordon, Charlottetown, was fined \$20 and costs or 10 days for speeding. He was clocked doing 45 m.p.h. on Elm Avenue, a 20-mile zone.

One man was fined \$30 and costs or 30 days for the illegal possession of liquor.

FREES WHITE GUNMEN

KANSAS CITY (AP)—Nine white men charged with assault with intent to kill after a series of shotgun attacks on homes by Negro youth gangs have pleaded guilty. Circuit Judge Harry A. Hall sentenced each to five years in prison and then granted them all five-year bench paroles. Ten persons, all Negroes, were injured by pellets from shotguns and other weapons in forays on homes early in October. Of the 12 charged in the attacks, two had the charges against them dismissed and one is awaiting trial.

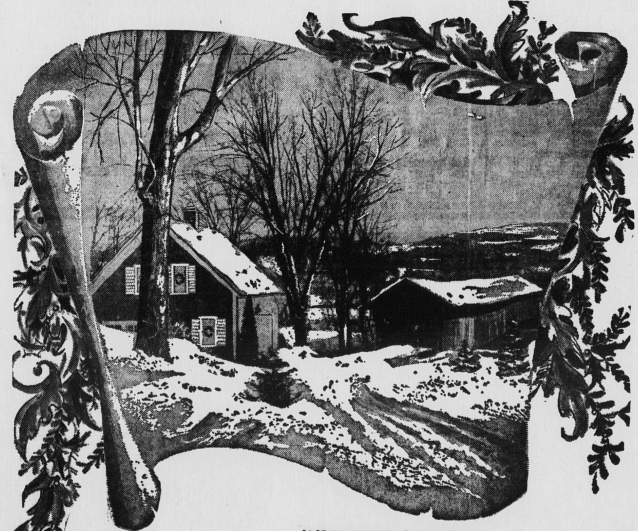
