The last CIMN volunteer meeting of the semester will be held on Friday, March 25, 2:30. All volunteers are to attend. Topics will include the year-end party.

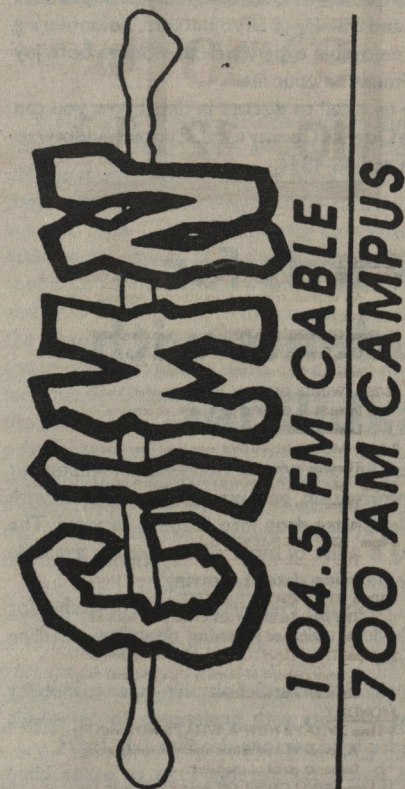
Anyone interested in joining CIMN's Labatt's 24 hour relay or Red Cross Relay teams, contact the management at the third floor of the Barn.
