THE following statement of disasters during the month of December has just been published: Steamers reported lost—11 British, 1 German, 1 Italian, 1 Dutch—total 14. In this number is included 1 steamer reported missing. Net tonnage, 11,675. Sailing vessels reported lost—46 British, 17 American, 11 German, 1 Austrian, 1 Brazilian, 3 Danish, 1 Spanish, 5 French, 2 Greek, 7 Italian, 19 Norwegian, 2 Dutch, 3 Russian, 6 Swedish—total 124. In this number are included 5 vessels reported missing. Net tonnage, 42,593.

MESSRS. PETERS & PETERS have sent a statement to the Governor General, briefly reviewing the facts in the recent trial of the unfortunate man Gillis, and showing the nature of the new evidence discovered since the trial, which, in their opinion, substantiates the claim. Accompanying this statement is another, signed by some of the grand jurors who examined the trunk in which they state that the vest found in Gillis' trunk and identified at the trial as Callaghan's, was not in the trunk at the time it was examined by them, so far as they can recollect.

A TELEGRAM to the Montreal Gazette reports that the Government has purchased for the National Gallery Mr. R. Harris' best picture, "The Meeting of Trustees in a Backwoods Settlement." It is pleasing to note that the Government are giving practical encouragement to art. Not many people in Canada have the wealth to expend money on costly paintings, nor the good taste to appreciate them. Great Confusion in Quebec!

SIR ADOLPHE CARON JUSTIFIED.

OTTAWA, Feb. 21. The St. Columbia meeting in Sir Adolphe Caron's constituency was a grand success for the Ministers who attended. There has not been so enthusiastic a reception given to Sir Adolphe for many a year. The managers of the National party hired ten or a dozen roughs, some of whom had only been out of the penitentiary a few weeks, and they were sent to try and break up the meeting. But the meeting was so overwhelmingly for the Government, that after enduring the interruption on several occasions, they turned upon the gang and summarily ejected them.

High Tide. ST. JOHN, Feb. 21. St. John and vicinity was visited by a tide generally said to be higher than that at the time of the famous Saxby gale, on the south and north wharves. The water rose to a depth of fully six inches over the western end, and soon the water came washing in the stores and warehouses. The marshes along the line of railway at Memramook, Dorchester and Sackville were overflowed with the highest tide known since the great Saxby tide of fifteen years ago. The damage by loss of hay stacked on the marshes will be large.

Frye and the Fisheries. WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 21. To-morrow being Washington's birthday, Senator Frye's address against further fishery negotiations will not be delivered. As the Education Bill, Bankruptcy Bill and the Washington Territory Bill will be strongly urged for precedence during the week, Frye will find some difficulty in getting the floor for his speech. He is, however, very anxious that the Senate should officially condemn further negotiations with Great Britain respecting the fisheries.

The Montreal Boy Again Victorious. ST. JOHN, N. B., Feb. 22. The match race at the Lansdowne Rink on Saturday evening, between Frank Dowd of Montreal, and Charles Whelpley, of this city, resulted in a victory for the Montreal boy. Time, 17.57. Another race has been arranged to come off at Latour Rink, where a round course can be had, on Tuesday night.

Socialists on the March. LONDON, Feb. 21. To-day the Socialists marched from all parts of London and massed 50,000 strong in Hyde Park. Mounted police patrolled the entrances of the Park, and strong reserves were held in readiness for an emergency. There was no attempt at riots.

The Final Vote. LONDON, Feb. 21. The powers have sent a final vote to Greece before blockading the Greeks fleet in Solomiasbug. Thirty thousand persons applied to the Mansion House for relief.

Civic Fraud. BOSTON, Feb. 20. A despatch from New York says that an immense civic swindle has just been unearthed, two of the city fathers confessing their own complicity and also giving the whole thing away.

Moonlighters Captured. DUBLIN, Feb. 21. The Castle Island police have just made a capture of nineteen armed and disguised men. They are supposed to be members of a party of moonlighters.

Destruction by Fire. WILMINGTON, N. C., Feb. 21. A destructive fire occurred in the business portion of this city this afternoon. The loss will probably exceed one million dollars.

Spanish Intrigue. PARIS, Feb. 21. It is reported a plot exists to unite Spain and Portugal and the Duke of Braganza and overthrow the present regency in Spain.

A State Entry. LONDON, Feb. 20. The Earl of Aberdeen, now Lord Lieut. of Ireland, made his State entry into Dublin to-day.
