# WHEN "DON'T WANTS" ARE GONE!

## DAILY MARKETS

**NEW YORK**  
 NEW YORK (AP) — It was another "blue Monday" for the New York stock market Monday—the third straight—and losses were almost as sharp as they were a week ago.  
 The Dow Jones industrial average fell 7.80 to 914.21 compared with its drop of 8.96 May 17. Volume totalled 4,790,000 shares compared with 4,660,000 Friday. Both figures are well below the 5,600,000 share daily average for the first four months.  
 Wall Street analysts were inclined to ascribe the loss to technical factors. The general news background was encouraging.  
 The Associated Press average of 60 stocks declined 2.5 to 335.6 with industrials off 3.9, rails off .4 to a new low for the year and utilities off 1.8. The decline was the sharpest since last Monday when the average lost 2.7.  
 Of 1,388 issues traded, 867 fell and 303 rose. New highs for the year totalled 26 and new lows 59.  
 General Motors lost 1 1/4, du Pont 3/4, General Electric 1 1/4, Westinghouse Electric 1 1/4, Union Carbide 1 1/4 and Eastman Kodak's new stock split 2-for-1, was down 2% on an adjusted basis.  
**IBM DROPS 9**  
 IBM fell 9 to 460. Boeing slipped 1 1/4. Douglas Aircraft 1 1/4, Merck 1 1/4 and Montgomery Ward 1 1/4.  
 Eight of the 15 most active stocks declined, six advanced and Radio Corp. was unchanged.  
 Curtis Publishing was the most active stock, up 2 to 10 1/4 on 166,400 shares. It was delayed in opening until early afternoon when it sold at 10 1/4 on an initial block of 65,000 shares. The company denied rumors that it had filed suit against Texas Gulf Sulphur in connection with its mineral holdings near Timmins, Ont. Texas Gulf lost 1 1/4.  
 Among "Canada" issues, Granby Mining gained 3/4, Distillers Seagrams 1/4 Canadian Nickel 1/4, Aluminium Ltd. 1/4, Dome Mines and McIntyre Porcupine 1/4, Walker Gooderham 1/4.  
 Prices on the American exchange were generally lower. Volume was 1,640,000 shares compared with 1,650,000 Friday.  
 Among Canadian issues, Brazilian Traction gained 1/4, Preston lost 1/4 and Scurry Rainbow Oil, Fargo Oil and Canadian Javelin 1/4.
