

# Castro Suggests Bigger Donations

 -BUENOS AIRES (AP) - Fidel Castro said Saturday the United States should provide \$30,000,000 over a 10-year period to achieve economic stability in Latin America.

The Cuban prime minister called for the U.S. to back such a program for Latin American development to thwart social upheavals he said might bring communist dictatorships.

He told the committee of the 21, the economic branch of the Organization of American States, that the figure he cited can come only from U.S. public funds and not from private investment.

**NO COMMENT**

There was no immediate comment from the U.S. delegation on Castro's speech. But the delegation already has made clear that it is reluctant to go beyond present commitments.

Formal speeches by delegates to the OAS committee meeting have closed and it was not known whether the U.S. would give a direct reply to Castro's appeal. Indications were that the Cuban

leader's plan may not even be brought up again.

The committee of the 21 opened its conference here Tuesday and the bearded Cuban prime minister flew here Saturday after visits to the U.S., Canada and Brazil.

**ROCKS CONFERENCE**

Castro rocked the usually sedate conference by his blunt speech lasting an hour and 20 minutes in which he suggested that the U.S. contribute \$30,000,000 over the next 10 years to Latin American countries to help them maintain political stability. He was applauded frequently and at the end was praised by many delegates.

Castro spoke extemporaneously and from a standing position. Other speakers have remained seated.

He declared that the United States had made great sacrifices to help restore Europe after the war and to aid lands of the Middle East. Now, he said, the United States must devote similar sacrifices to bring economic well-being to the Western Hemisphere.

Speaking with a daring not voiced by other delegates here, he declared United States help to Latin America is not sufficient.

The United States already has expressed itself as opposed to going beyond its present aid commitments in this hemisphere.

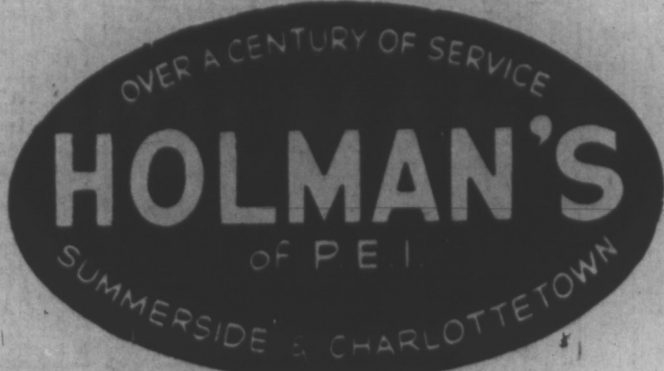
Sincere sympathy is being extended to Mr. Russell Ramsey upon the death of his brother, the late Hugh Ramsey, who passed away recently.

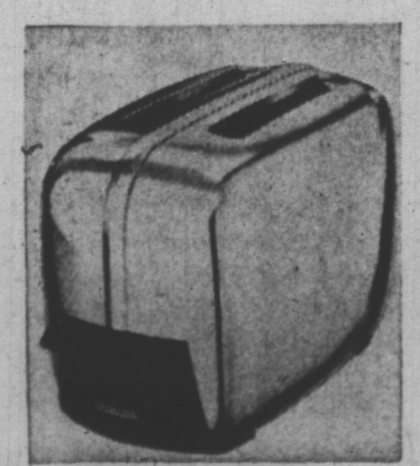
