INNOCENCE AT THE BRIDGE TABLE

It is very difficult, in this sophisticated bridge age, to find opponents who are glibly enough to be "psyched" out of their obviously best contract. But it can still be done occasionally. Take the following case for notable example. South was a novice—he had played in bridge clubs for many years. Yet, he fell for one of the most transparent hoaxes imaginable—the sort of hoax that

should not succeed one time in a hundred. East dealer. East-West vulnerable.

It is hard to believe that South could have paid so little attention to his partner's double of one heart. As may be seen, a four-heart contract by North-South would have gone down one (because the heart king was off-side) whereas four spades went down

1400! The moment South heard North double the one-heart bid, he should have known that West was psyching and that hearts was the only contract for North-South. Thus, South of course

should have bid hearts. West opened the diamond queen; East won and shifted to the ace, led a trump to the queen. (Continued on page 15)

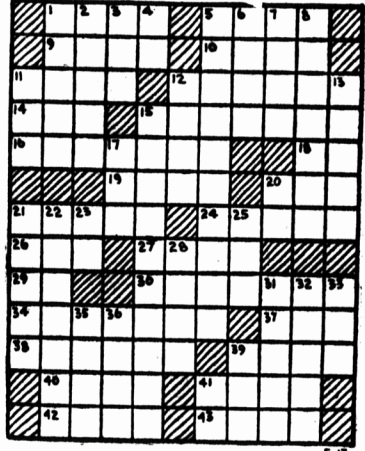

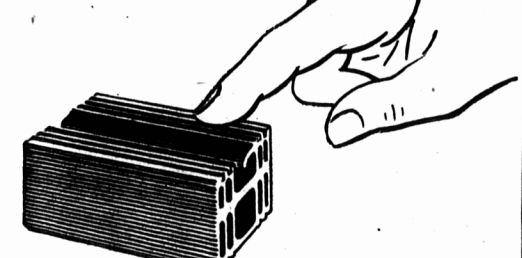
This interruption is for the purpose of moving poles to allow for government road widening.
