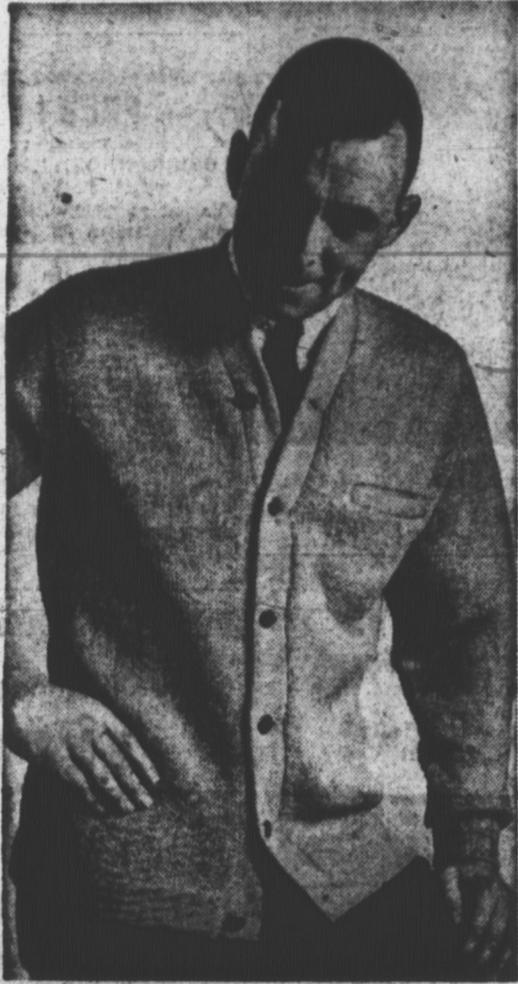

### Kohler Co. And Union End Dispute

MILWAUKEE, Wis. (AP)—The Kohler company and the United Auto Workers Union announced they have reached a final agreement settling their 11 1/2-year dispute.

Emil Mazey, secretary-treasurer of the UAW, told a press conference that the firm will pay \$3,000,000 in back wages and \$1,500,000 to reinstate pensions. Seated beside Mazey was Lyman C. Conger, Kohler vice-president and negotiating committee chairman, bringing together again the two men who had led the opposing forces from the first day of the strike April 5, 1954.

The agreement is conditioned upon approval of the National Labor Relations Board and the Circuit Court of Appeals in Washington.

Mazey also announced that the UAW and Kohler have reached agreement on a new contract, but terms will not be disclosed until after a membership meeting Saturday night.

The Kohler workers will start receiving their back pay in January, Mazey said. The amount will vary, ranging up to \$10,000 in the case of one individual worker. A total of 1,400 former strikers will share in the settlement awards. Neither the UAW or Local 833 will receive any financial settlement, Mazey said.

Kohler manufactures plumbing-ware at its huge plant at Kohler, Wis.

The strike began April 5, 1954, and at the outset involved 2,775 of Kohler's 3,300 production workers. Kohler resumed production within a short time after the strike began. In April, 1956, the company claimed that it was operating at 65 per cent of normal.

### Quebec Group Bidding For Chips Export

QUEBEC (CP)—The Association of Saw Wood Manufacturers of Quebec has asked the provincial lands and forests department to authorize the export of wood chips to Great Britain.

The association, in a brief to the department, said one English firm is interested in buying 200,000 tons of wood chips a year.

The brief complained of the present situation with the pulp and paper companies.

Rene Barry, managing secretary of the association, said: "Either we have to accept the contract conditions laid down by the companies or we have to burn the wood chips."

Leslie Cliche, lands and forests minister, replied that, if he were to grant the request, it would virtually mean authorizing the export of cord wood at a time when Quebec is trying to do everything it can to deal with this natural resource at home.

The brief by the association was one of 40-odd that the department has received in a week of public hearings. The department plans to issue a white paper which would be the basis for a new law on lands and forests.

### Miner Import Plan Sparks Angry Protests

TORONTO (CP)—Kerr Addison Mines Ltd.'s plan to import some 250 miners from Italy has triggered angry protests from the United Steelworkers of America (USWA).

"It is typical of the mining industry to solve a problem of a shortage of miners by robbing Italy instead of training Canadians and paying them decent wages," said union economist Donald Taylor.

Mines Minister Wardrop of Ontario said Thursday the Italians will be brought in if present restrictions against low education levels are relaxed by Ottawa. Kerr Addison has promised to upgrade the educational levels of the men once they are here.

"There are plenty of people in Canada whose educational levels could be uplifted if Kerr Addison wanted to make the investment," said Murray Cotterill, public relations director of the union, which represents more than 27,000 Ontario hard rock miners.

He added that substantially higher pay would bring scores of miners to Kerr Addison which has an independent union.

### ACCUSE WEST GERMANS

UNITED NATIONS (CP)—Soviet Ambassador Nikolai T. Fedorenko told the United Nations General Assembly's main political committee Saturday West German militarists are the only group in Europe trying to lay claim to the territories of other countries. "The Bonn militarist regime, with the support of the United States and certain other powers, is trying to frustrate good neighborly relations," Fedorenko said.

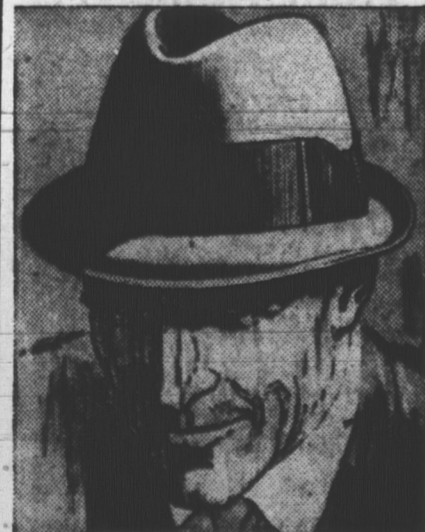

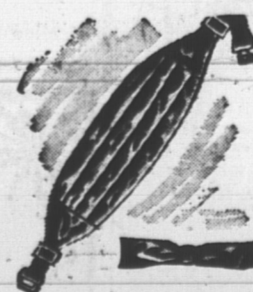

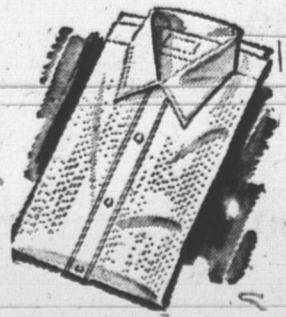
