

**LIVE REINDEER
BEING SOUGHT**

OTTAWA (CP) — With the Christmas season coming on, it was bound to happen. Somebody called the federal government to find out where he could buy a live reindeer.

The unidentified caller from Toronto temporarily stymied the government switchboard operator.

After some hesitation she connected him with the Canadian Wildlife Service where he quickly got the needed information.

Apparently most native reindeer are protected by game regulations and can not be legally bought or sold. However, there are several farms in the Western provinces which do sell live reindeer.

If that didn't work out, a prospective reindeer buyer could contact the owners of the reindeer herd which is situated at the Mackenzie River delta in the Northwest Territories. This herd is run as a commercial enterprise.

**Pearson Denies
Early Election**

OTTAWA (CP)—Prime Minister Pearson has discounted any intention of calling an early general election.

He said in the Commons that contrary to some reports the government intends to proceed with a full program for the current Parliament. The present Parliament was elected in April and its maximum term would be five years.

Mr. Pearson said in reply to Grant Deschman (L.—Vancouver Quadra) that if an election is called it will be the responsibility of others. The Liberals hold fewer Commons seats than the four opposition parties combined.

Opposition Leader Diefenbaker said Tuesday night that an early election might be expected.

**Wheat Glass
Said Magnified**

OTTAWA (CP)—Stories about glass in wheat shipments to Russia have been magnified, Transport Minister McElraith said in the Commons, with apologies for the pun.

He said in reply to a series of opposition questions that there has been no suggestion of sabotage or of a conspiracy.

The matter appeared one of pure carelessness by persons who had to work in dusty conditions. Soft drink concessions on wheat-shipping docks had been ordered to switch to paper cups from bottles.

Justice Minister Chevrier said in reply to Douglas Fisher (NDP—Port Arthur) that there is no indication to indicate industrial sabotage by the F.I.Q. (Federation de Liberation Quebecois).

Mr. McElraith added that glass has been found in two boxes from Ontario ports, one of them a shipment of soya beans.

**Statement On
Flag, Anthem
Promised Soon**

OTTAWA (CP)—Prime Minister Pearson said in the Commons he will make a statement "in a very few days" on the question of a distinctive national flag and anthem.

Pierre-Andre Bouthin (Creditiste—Dorchester) asked Mr. Pearson if the government will propose the adoption of "O Canada" and a distinctive flag as it had promised to do, or would the promise be repeated at the next election.

**Session Work
Seen Dragging**

OTTAWA (CP)—Prospects of the parliamentary session ending before Christmas are not too good unless business speeds up, Secretary of State Pickersgill, government House Leader, said in the Commons.

He said more progress will have to be made on both legislation and approval for the spending programs of the various departments for the fiscal year ending next March 31.

If it had been expected that this first session of the 26th Parliament would end about Dec. 20 and that a second session would be called early next year.
