

Inspector Stresses Value Of Safty Week Campaign

"Eight lives were lost on Prince Edward Island by drowning in 1955," said Inspector Eric L. Martin of the P.E.I. Division of the R.C.M.P. yesterday in an interview with The Guardian, "and that is a far too high ratio for a Province of this size."

Inspector Martin was speaking on behalf of the Safty Week campaign being carried on by the Canadian Red Cross this week. He said: "I heartily endorse the campaign by the Red Cross to promote water safety and I would suggest that the general public not only pay attention for this week but for the whole year and every year."

"I strongly suggest further that the public get copies of the Red Cross 'Eleven Rules for Water Safty.' Parents should acquire the rules for safe swimming and safe boating, study them carefully and follow them always whenever swimming, boating, or later on, hunting."

Inspector Martin suggested a booklet entitled "Water Safty" that could be read with great benefit by everyone but is especially informative to owners and operators of small craft. "This booklet contains concise information on life saving equipment, fire prevention, the operation of small boats, safty rules and much other valuable and informative material. It is published by the Department of Transport and can be acquired free of charge at any local detachment of the R.C.M.P."

"I would not only request need for safty in water," said Inspector Martin, "but also need for safty when walking or driving to fishing grounds, beaches or going about daily activities."

"The number of elementary rules of safty, both drivers and pedestrians, is astonishing. Failure to observe safty rules can only re-

sult in an increase in the already alarming loss both human and economical suffered in this country every year.

"The only way to reduce accidents in homes, water and on the road is by obedience to safty rules, observance of laws and regulations and common sense. If everyone did this there would be a tremendous drop in the number of accidents of all kinds."

Inspector Martin concluded the interview on a note of caution and warning: "The Canada Shipping Act relating to small boats should, by this time, be well known to boat owners and operators. People who refuse to conform with the act and regulations made under the act face the possibility of prosecution."
