period and with a little care and carryover our volume of meats could be greatly increased by better finishing and heavier weights. It is unfortunate that cattle are going to market half finished and under weight with many dairy cows and heifers particularly diverted to the slaughter pens.

Potatoes

The potato market continues anemic. The supplies, however, are not as high as last year, and it is felt that the season will drain off practically all our production but not at buoyant prices.

United States figures show that the holdings of potatoes in that country are about three million bushels less than last year. There is no life to the tablestock market and bad weather all over the South has slowed the seed demand. In addition cars are very short and everybody is behind in their orders.
