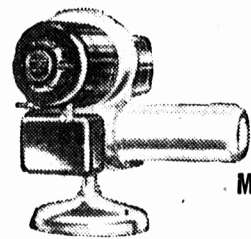

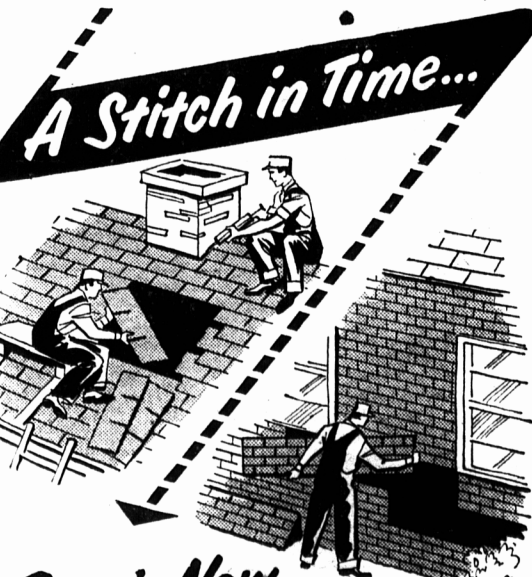

Aircraft Carrier Going to Scrap-Yard

PORTSMOUTH, Eng. (Reuters)—The 23,000-ton aircraft carrier Formidable, obsolete after less than nine years' service, left Portsmouth Thursday for the scrap-yard. Launched in 1939, she has been in reserve since 1948. The admiralty said last year that only complete modernization could enable her to operate under present conditions and the expense would not be justified.

M. C. A. STAFF TO GO ON DAYLIGHT TIME

Effective Monday, May 11th, the staff of Maritime Central Airways go on Daylight Saving Time.

The decision which was announced yesterday was made after repeated requests from the staff who wanted the extra hour in the evening.

The Maintenance Department, the Accounting Department, and the Administrative Staff will all be included on the new time, but the Traffic Agents and Line Crews, who service the scheduled flights, will be on Standard Time because the flights will continue as before on this old time.

In observing the new Daylight Time the Company made it known that they are following the trend which is gaining in popularity among the largest airlines of North America. At the present time most of the American Airlines are on Daylight Time and it has been learned that commencing on July 1st, Trans-Canada Air Lines will also go on local time.

The trend of the larger Airlines in going on Daylight Time is hinged mainly around the argument that the passenger should not be burdened with any other time than that which he observes himself locally. To do otherwise is to make himself subject to calculations which are annoying and to which he should not be subject.

The working staff of all of these Airlines have always observed Daylight Time since its inception. Although, all Maritime Central Airways flights will continue for the present on Standard Time, the new Daylight Time will give the many employees of the Airlines extra free time in the evening.

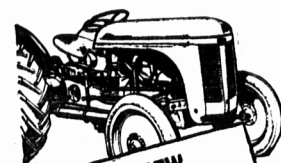
