### THRONE LIGHTS.

### TEACHERS AND TEACHING.

In all Europe there are 6,274 professors in the colleges and universities.

In Greece teachers contribute 5 per cent of their salaries and the state finds the remainder in order to superannuate teachers after 21 years of service, regardless of age.

Dun Kelt House, the residence of the Earl of Crawford in Aberdeenshire, has been sold by him to a number of Scottish noblemen who intend to found a Scottish public school on the lines of Eton, Harrow and Rugby.

J. W. Stanford, a nephew of the late Senator Stanford and a trustee of Leland Stanford university, said recently that the demand for admission to that institution was greater than can be met. They were forced to refuse admission to 300 who passed the last examinations.

### TREE TIPS.

Setting a good, stout stake by the side of a crooked growing tree and tying it will often help in straightening it.

The peach will bear more and better fruit if kept trimmed back, and the fruit will be more evenly distributed over the tree.

After the trees have been growing long enough to become well established any deep stirring of the soil is certain to break or injure the roots.

In setting out trees at any time trim the ends of the roots and broken parts, spread out the roots in their natural position and press the soil closely about them.

Scattering a liberal dressing of salt under the pear tree is recommended as a good remedy for blight. It also helps to make plant food in the soil available.
