WINNIPEG, Sept. 19 - (CP) - Prices were irregular today in moderately active trade on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange.
Good commercial demand came into barley, including some export purchases in connection with a reported sale of 400,000 bushels of Canadian barley to the United Kingdom.
American house demand appeared in oats in a small way. Offerings and hedges were moderate. Industrial accounts picked up flax on the declines, while American houses purchased rye.
Some of the buying was prompted by reports of further rains in northern Saskatchewan, again delaying harvesting.
Export loadings of Canadian wheat were small, with 725,000 bushels going to Belgium, 100,000 to the United Kingdom and 35,000 to the Netherlands.
Class two wheat and I.W.A. prices were up three-eighths cents, except in the No. 4 northern, which were down five-eighths.
