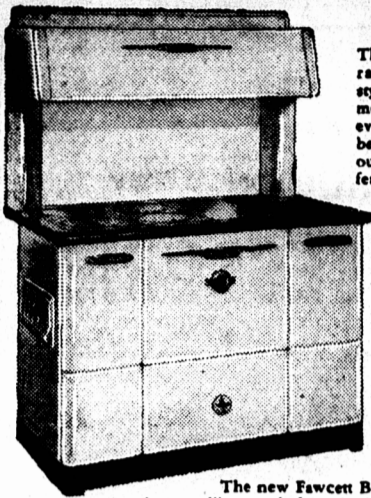

Strange But True

A 25-year-old halibut was caught recently off the coast of British Columbia only a few miles from the spot where it was tagged and released in 1928 by an International Fisheries Commission research vessel. It was the oldest tagged halibut ever taken, according to Fish and Wildlife Service biologists, though some have been known to reach 38-years of age. Despite its comparative long life it weighed only 12 pounds dressed—a fourth of the real weight of most aged halibut. The average age of halibut taken from B. C. waters is nine to ten years.

The dangerous thing about an iceberg is that some 7-8 of its bulk is submerged and you never know when it will shift its center of gravity. The grim death struggle between an eagle and a fox in our northland seems worth recording here. Apparently the giant bird had attacked the fox. The fox finally managed to kill his attacker but it was a hollow victory, for the eagle's strong talons were sunk deep into Reynard's throat even after the big bird was dead. The fox had evidently suffered a lingering death in the grip of the dead bird, from which there was no escape, and both were disintegrating in the field of battle.

During the Klondike gold strike, bread sold for \$4 a pound, a piece of pie cost 75 cents, a dish of canned tomatoes was \$1.25, and a bowl of mush and a cup of coffee could be had for \$1. But even at the present high cost of steak this makes us shudder. A serving of steak was \$3. All food, and in fact everything else, was sold by weight and purchased by gold dust weighed on tiny scales.

Melmerby, England, is noted for what are called the Helm winds, a curious phenomenon caused by the cold air above the mountains when the countryside around about has not a leaf stirring the village may have to battle with a full-blown gale. It can be heard roaring down from the mountains. The cloud which appears to rest on the hills is called the Helm Bar.

Canada's record moose of 20-year's standing was deposed last fall when little Dave Moses, Indian resident of Mayo, Y.T., bagged a moose with an antler spread of 76 1/8 inches. The previous record for this country was a 73-inch spread shot near the Peace River in 1922.

Friday, 13, can be a very unlucky day, says a resident of King's county depending of course upon one's point of view. Take Friday, last spring on the 13th day of May. Our local trapper—his wishes his name withheld—caught an oversized skunk and its mate in twin traps. The female, had given birth to six skunklets, making a total of 8 skunks worth \$8 in bounty, unlucky enough to end their lives on Friday 13.

Long-eared breeds of dogs such as are used in Canada's bad lands are often mistaken for wolves and vice versa. But closer observation will reveal this difference. The pupil of the dog's eye being round and that of the wolf oblique.

The great Barrier Reef off the coast of Queensland extends for 1200 miles and is unique of its kind in the world and of inexhaustible interest. Seen from a glass-bottomed boat it presents an amazingly strange picture, colored in all the rainbow hues and shaped as variously in and among the coral swim fishes blue, red, yellow, green, purple, etc. It is the most lovely thing in the land down under. The most famous of the marsupial animals that carry their young in pouches is the kangaroo but wallabies, wombats and Kalas are just as strange. It is the Kalas that sat as a model for the world famous teddy bear.

Even stranger than these is the duck-billed platypus. This curious creature which grows to a length of two feet is considered by scientists the most primitive of living mammals. Its body is covered with fur; its snout looks like the bill of a duck; and believes it is the Kalas that lays eggs and suckles its young.

There are many birds of brilliant plumage that can't sing a note and beautiful flowers whose blossoms have no smell. The flower as boronia has small, cup-like blossoms, usually brown inside and golden green inside, with a dark leaf and stem and a pungent perfume is made. The flannel flower is so named because the texture and color of the petals and center look like real flannel.

The Australians send more telegraphic messages per head each year than any other people in the world. The telephone system is also highly developed, ranking seventh among the countries of the world in density of phones. Both systems are under the control of the post office, a commonwealth function. The private radio stations obtain their revenue from advertising; and make a contribution to the post office in the form of a license fee.

The Tasmanian government actually derives a quarter of its revenue from lottery taxes. At the University of Alaska museum may be seen the skin of the largest bear ever killed. The monster pelt measured 12 feet, 4 inches, by 10 feet, 4 inches, and the skull, 19 3/16 by 11 1/2 inches. The very latest creation in lad-
