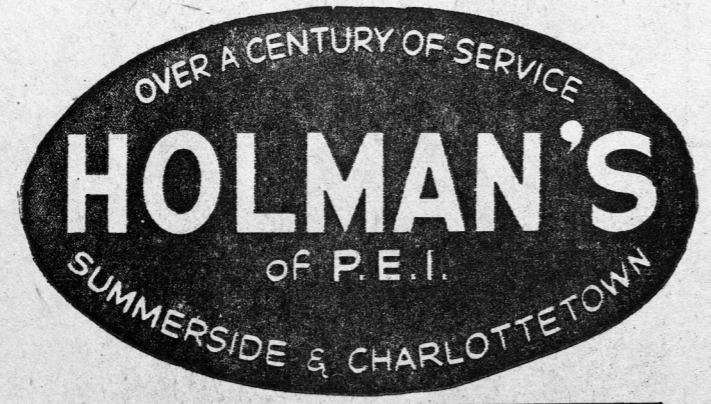

He asked the members to try and support their Co-op and so put it on a sound foundation.

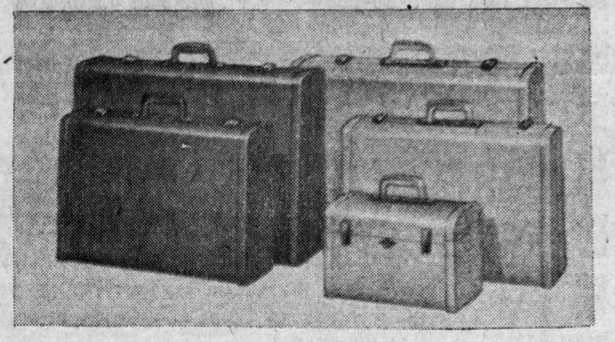

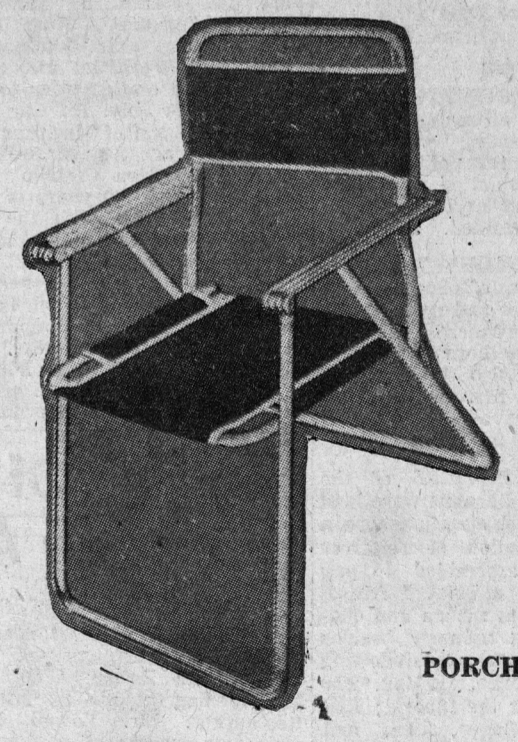
