

**Move To Centralize Control
of Space Weapons In U. S.**

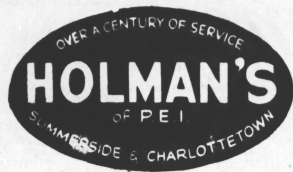
WASHINGTON (AP)—A Democratic party move to pull together all of the United States government's research and development activities under a new department of science appears to be gaining ground.

Senator Hubert Humphrey of Minnesota said Saturday a study begun by the staff of the Senate government operations committee before the Russian Sputnik launchings has "disclosed a crying need" for centralized control of space weapons and other developments.

Senator Mike Mansfield of Montana, the assistant Senate Democratic leader, said in a separate interview that a single mission should be included in agency, whose head would be responsible only to President Eisenhower, should supervise the race to catch up with Russia in missiles and satellites.

Senator Estes Kefauver of Tennessee said he would introduce legislation to create a science department, which he is a member, to embrace this proposal in any report it makes on its continuing inquiry into the rocketry program.

Humphrey said a government operations subcommittee here he hears will begin public hearings in January on the proposed consolidation of basic and applied scientific research and development work.
