

Veterans Minister Given Volume Of CEF History

OTTAWA (CP) — Veterans Minister Churchill, a veteran of both world wars, has been presented with a copy of the one-volume history of the First World War "Canadian Expeditionary Force, 1914-1919".

Mr. Churchill, who served overseas as a machine gunner from 1916 until 1919, said the history, written by Col. G. W. L. Nicholson who retired earlier this year as head of the Canadian Army historical section, documents one of the highlights of Canadian history.

"Had it not been for Canada's effort in the First World War, we would not have been represented at the council table when the peace treaties were signed, nor admitted as an independent nation at the League of Nations."

"The argument for treating Canada as a separate nation was based upon her effort during the First World War."

TAUGHT LESSON

Mr. Churchill, who commanded a Canadian armored unit during the Second World War, said the experience outlined in Col. Nicholson's book teaches a lesson about employ-

ment of armed forces that should have been applied in the Second World War.

Canadian troops, he said, gained battle experience in the First World War as individual units before taking the field as an army corps. Such a policy would have been valuable in the Second World War but efforts were not made to give effective battle training to the Canadian forces before they went into action.
