Back to Work For Steel Workers

SYDNEY, (CP) — Seventy men were called to work at the Sydney steel plant here today and company officials indicated that the employment situation for the future is bright.

The hirings reversed a trend of layoffs which took 1,400 men off the plant's payroll since last October. The present working force is estimated at 4,335.

One company spokesman predicted more men should be called back day to day and said the present outlook is the brightest in months.

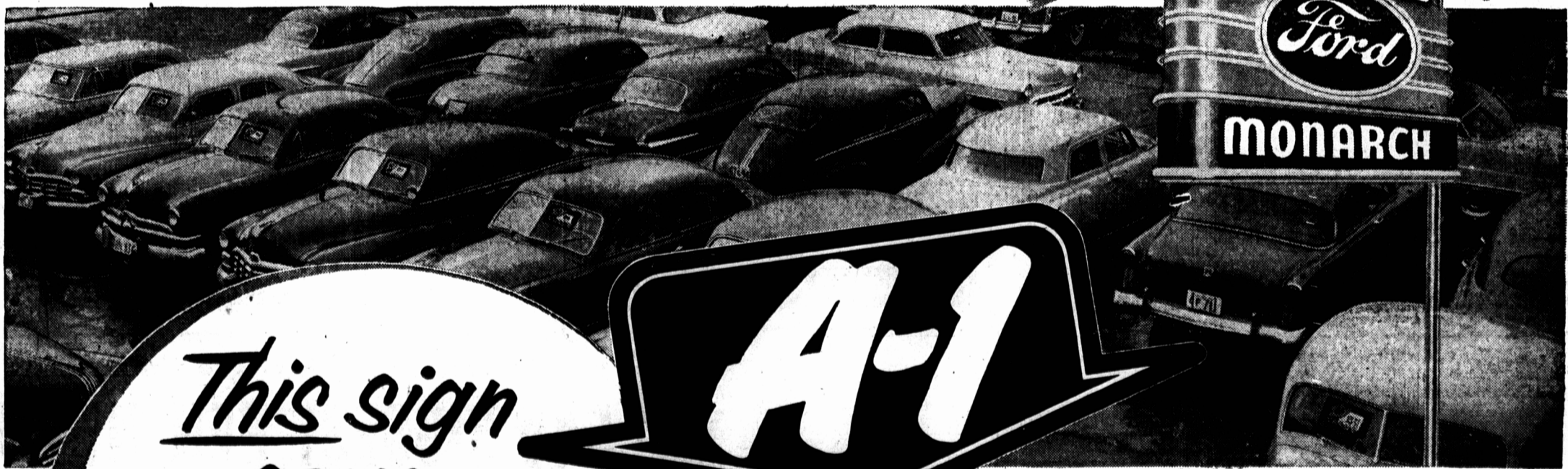
