MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR PROJECT FOR NOVA SCOTIA FISH INDUSTRY

HALIFAX (CP)—Nova Scotia's herring fisheries received their biggest boost Friday when the province signed a financial agreement with the newly formed, foreign-backed Mercury Fisheries Limited of Halifax.

The company, bolstered by an undisclosed industrial loan from the provincial government, will prosecute the industry in the Gulf of St. Lawrence and Nova Scotia waters with British crews trained in the drift netting and other trawling methods of the rich North sea fishery.

Trade and Industry Minister, W. T. Dauphinee, who made the announcement Friday night, said processing plants would be established at Pictou, on the province's mainland, and at Cheticamp on Cape Breton Island.

SEEN MULTI-MILLION PLAN
Value of the industry was not mentioned, but it was understood to be a multi-million dollar project. Four trawlers alone are being negotiated for at Lowestoft, England. It is expected that the vessel's crews will also be hired there.

Mr. Dauphinee described fishing magnate Paul Stockhamer of London and Great Yarmouth, England, as the "moving light" behind Mercury Fisheries.

Under the financial agreement, some of the capital cost and all of the working capital comes from British and United States sources.

LOAN'S MAJOR ROLE
Most of the capital cost has been provided by the government's loan. Until now, most of Nova Scotia's herring have been caught by the drift netting method allows gill nets to float on the surface, and otter-trawling catches the herring in a bag-like net towed by trawler.

Plane Crash-Lands Safely
SYDNEY (CP)—A twin-engine plane carrying two men and a dead geologist crashed safely Friday night into desolate Nutter's Barrens after its pilot barely missed a dozen buildings while seeking the Sydney airport.

The Northern Wings Limited pilot, identified only as Laurent, suffered a slight leg injury. He became lost in a fogbank and after roof-hopping over the industrial district told the control tower he was going to crash-land in what appeared to be a field.

The control tower, knowing that nearly all "fields" in the district are treacherous, tree-dotted bogs, told him not to try it. Laurent, a veteran bush pilot, slipped into the bog and advanced parties back from the scene said the plane was hardly damaged.

The plane, which went down about 8:50 p. m. ADT, was en route from Sept Isles, Que., to the airport here with the body of Allan MacIntyre of Glace Bay, N. S., who drowned with a companion last Friday at Knot Lake, Labrador.

The plane was an Anson, a reconnaissance aircraft used during the Second World War and retired early this year by the RCAF.

Fire Damages In Atlantic City
ATLANTIC CITY, N. J. (AP)—Fire Friday swept the Atlantic City boardwalk and spread to the nearby motor.

The fire apparently started under the boardwalk, caught on the boardwalk itself and then spread to the pier, one of Atlantic City's major amusement attractions.

Thousands of spectators milled about on the adjoining beach and on the boardwalk and streets leading to it as firemen battled the flames.

Flanders Denounces McCarthy AS "FIFTH AMENDMENT SENATOR"

WASHINGTON (AP)—Senator Ralph Flanders (Rep. Vt.) Friday accused Senator Joseph McCarthy (Rep.-Wis.) of such contemptuous conduct that he "can scarcely be called a fifth amendment senator."

The charge was contained in the text of the speech Flanders prepared for delivery Friday night in connection with his resolution to condemn McCarthy for conduct that "deserves to bring the Senate into disrepute."

Flanders charged his colleague with "habitual contempt for people." He described McCarthy as a man no more susceptible to appeasement than Adolf Hitler and the Kremlin.

PERSONAL CONTEMPT
By refusing to answer questions raised by a Senate sub-committee in 1952 about his integrity and financial affairs, Flanders said, McCarthy showed personal contempt of the sub-committee and Senate.

"He continues to refuse answering he finds himself in the same category as the fifth amendment Communist. He is quite evidently occupying the same ground and can scarcely avoid being called a fifth amendment senator."

The "fifth amendment" reference was to the section of the Constitution which says a person cannot be compelled to testify against himself. McCarthy has given the name "fifth amendment Communist" to persons who pleaded possible self-incrimination in refusing to answer questions before his Senate sub-committee.
