

Indonesian Rebels Down But Not Out

SINGAPORE (AP) — Indonesian rebels demonstrated with well-aimed bombs and bullets this week that they have not ended their struggle against President Sukarno's central government.

While government forces closed the ring on rebel troops in Central Sumatra, other rebels in North Celebes sent bombers into action.

The insurgents provided evidence that they can carry on their fight for some time unless the government immediately swings the full weight of its military might against rebellious eastern Indonesia. Many of the government's best troops now are busy trying to end the war in central Sumatra.

With remarkable accuracy, the small rebel air force sank a British tanker and Italian freighters. They also bombed two Indonesian ships — one obtained recently from Russia—and one vessel of Panamanian registry chartered to an Indonesian firm.

Four-Year Term For Strangling Sister-in-law

LONDON (AP) — A mild-mannered mother of five children was sentenced Friday to four years in prison for strangling a sister-in-law who came for a two-week visit and stayed seven years.

Mrs. Edith Daisy Chubb, 46, was found not guilty of murder but convicted of manslaughter at the end of a three-day trial in Old Bailey Criminal court.

A jury of nine men and three women heard how the weary, kind-hearted woman worked for her household—five children, her plumber husband, her mother, mother-in-law and sister-in-law.

The court was told that Mrs. Chubb short of money to feed her family, worked all night three times a week as a hospital nurse. She also did baby sitting and cleaned floors in a factory and private homes. Her housework was done in spare moments.

Mrs. Chubb testified that her sister-in-law, 52-year-old Lillian Chubb, paid her only 25s a week for her room and never helped in the house.

One day Mrs. Chubb, mixing soap powder in the kitchen while her sister-in-law was drinking tea, became enraged. She pulled a scarf over Miss Chubb's neck.

"I intended to give her a good shaking up, you know," she said. But Miss Chubb fell backwards, choking, and struck her head on the stairs.

Mrs. Chubb testified that her sister-in-law, 52-year-old Lillian Chubb, paid her only 25s a week for her room and never helped in the house.

Dr. Jay Orear, assistant professor at Columbia University in New York, proposed walling off a section of a deep canyon, lining and roofing it with steel, insulating the chamber with dirt on top and setting off the bombs inside.

The idea was outlined in a paper prepared for a meeting of the American Physical Society.

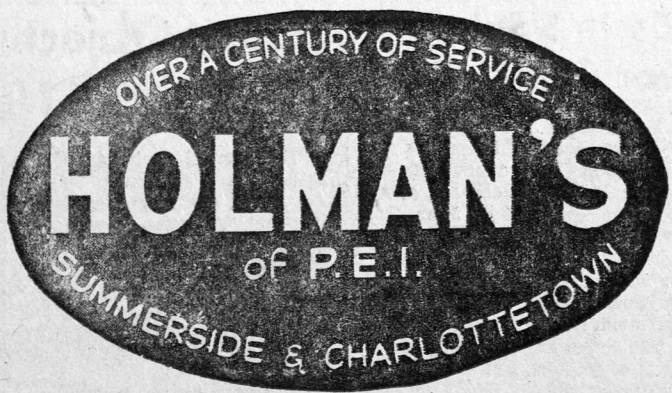
His many friends will be sorry to learn that Mr. Fred Champion of Malpeque is confined to his home through illness. All hope for his speedy recovery.

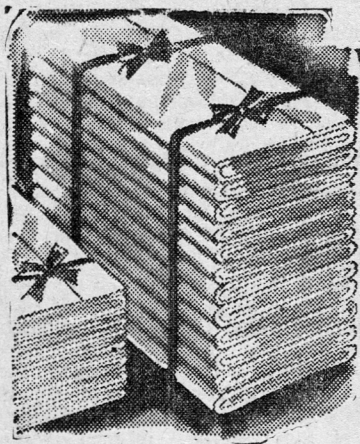
Mr. Eric Grant, Sackville, N.B. was the weekend guest of Mr. and Mrs. Bruce Crozier and family of Balfour.
