CURRENCIES

MONTREAL (CP)—The U.S. dollar closed Wednesday at a discount of 3 15-16 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, up 1-82. Pound sterling \$2.67 1/2, unchanged.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP)—The stock market rambled about Wednesday with little interest and closed with signs of a slight upward turn.

Gold led the index winners with a gain of nearly a point but base metals and western oils were ahead less than one-half point.

The market opened with little trend and continued that way through the entire session. At the close there was a majority of stocks on the upside but advances in most cases were narrow and a definite trend was hard to detect.

Coppers were firm following the news that the London market had received a price increase. Opemiska climbed 50 cents to \$9 while several other issues added 10-20 cents. Senior base metals were fractionally higher, thus accounting for a one-half point advance in the base metal index.

Western oils were quiet and few prominent price changes were noticed. Crude lost 25 cents at \$5 and Canadian Oil was up 12 cents to \$2.10.

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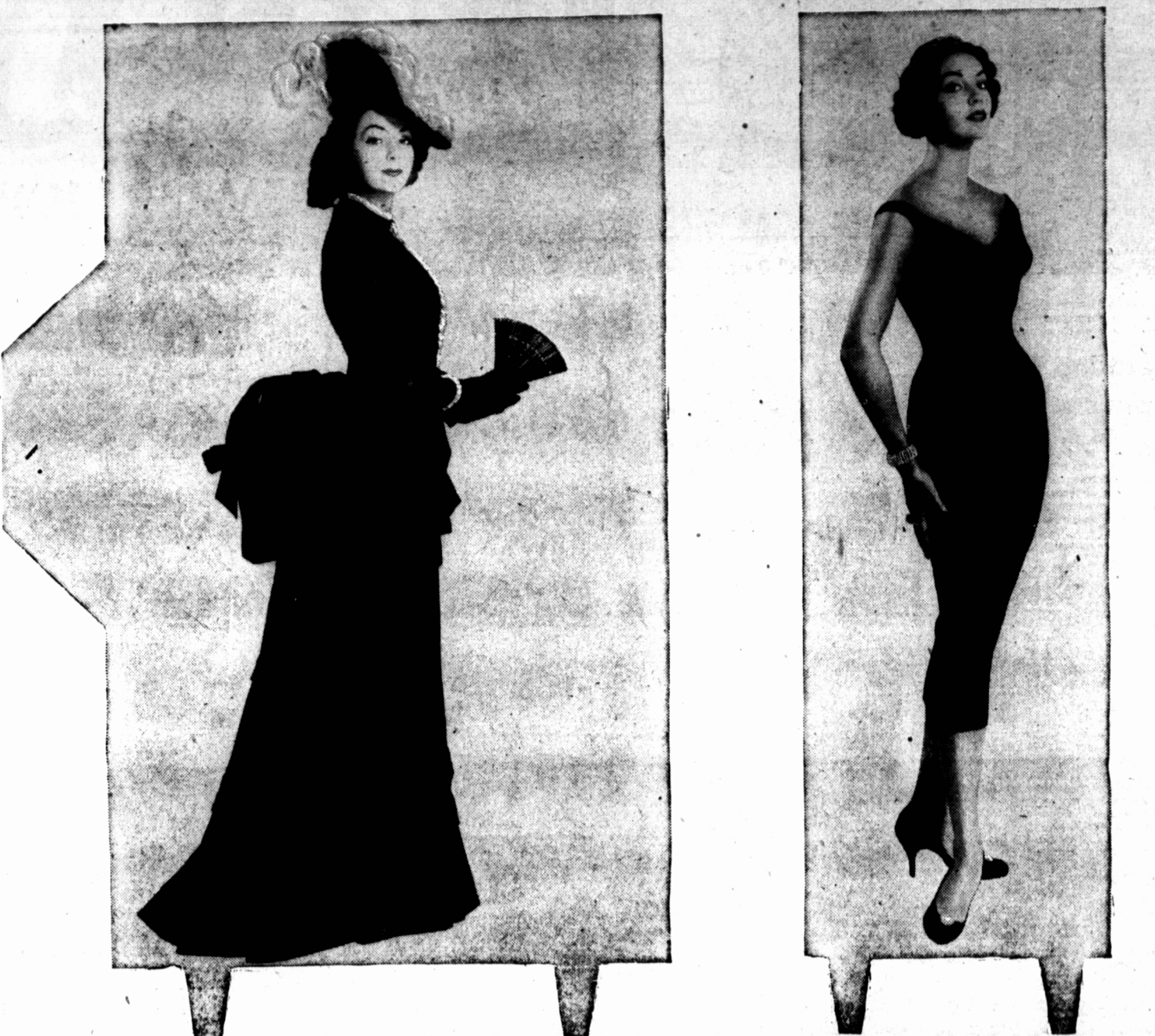
