

quate youth treatment centres.”

With her first film, *Letters to a Street Child*, she started a foundation to research the feasibility of getting a treatment centre in Toronto. The research has been completed and the group is now in the process of fundraising. “We would like it to be a cookie-cutter thing, so that every community can decide to adopt this,” Cazabon explained, adding that the number of addicted youth is rising, and that the resources were not adequate for the 1980’s and still aren’t in 2001.

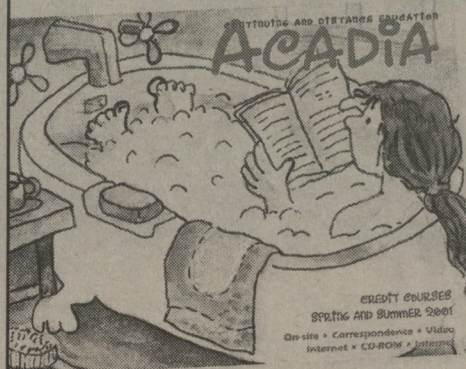
Through out the promotional tour for *No Quick Fix*, which has been sponsored by Canada Youth Employment Strategy, Cazabon has asked her audience for comments on the issue, and plans to bring these to the last stop of the tour, Parliament Hill. Cazabon would like to see the federal government

make a commitment to working towards helping street youth off the streets and into treatment centres, where they can regain their life or get a fresh start.

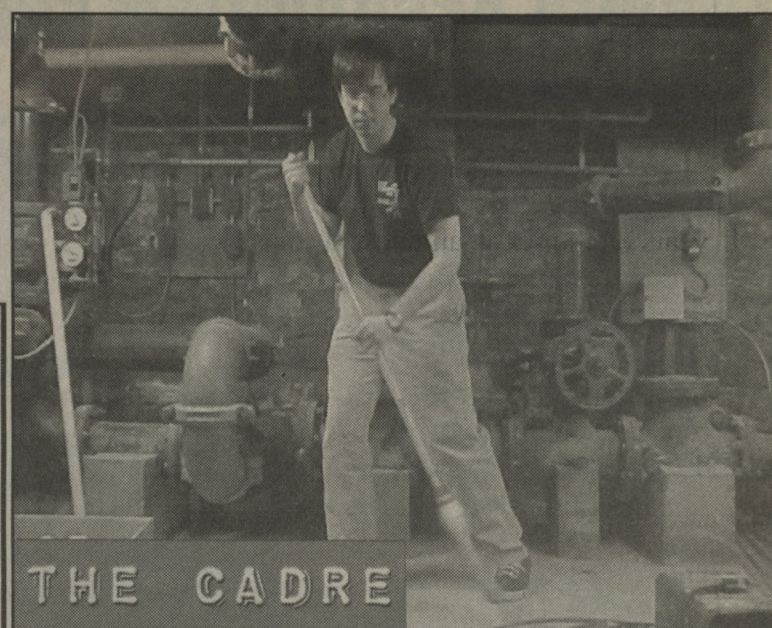
