Doug Sanders And Meister Lead Field In Can. Ch'ships

EDMUNDSTON, N. B. (CP) — Doug Sanders of Miami Beach, Fla., the reigning Canadian Open golf champion, and Ed Meister of Willoughby, Ohio led a field of 64 qualifiers for the Canadian amateur golf tournament today.

Sanders—with 72 Tuesday—and Meister, with 69 tied with qualifying totals of 142, four under par, and were one stroke up on Moe Norman of Kitchener, Ont., who carded a one-over-par 74 after a 69 Monday.

The field, reduced from a starting array of some 115 amateurs representing eight Canadian provinces and the United States, played out the second round Tuesday amid driving rain, showers and generally miserable weather.

The elements—and the course's demanding layout—made scores high. Norman had a two-under-par 67 after 15 holes. He then went over on the final hole to finish three holes—three straight fives.

Monday he had fired birdies on the 17th and 18th holes. Top Canadian behind Norman Tuesday was Bob Kild, captain of the runner-up British Columbia Willoughby Cup team, who toured the fairways in the same threesome as Norman and scored a one-under-par 72. His two-round total was even par 74-72-146.

Of the six competitors who beat par in qualifying play, Meister and Art Butler of Portsmouth, N.H., turned in second round 69's Tuesday. Bill Fote, Jr. of Huntington Beach, Calif. shot 71-74 and 145 teeing Butler and Ted Lenzyk of Willoughby, Ohio, who was 70-75.

The medal play qualifying rounds, played Monday and Tuesday, were run off in conjunction with the interprovincial Willoughby Cup matches—won by the Ontario team—and the Canadian junior championship—won by Norman's clubmate at Kitchener, 17-year-old Gary Cowan.

A two round medal score of 163 was enough to qualify for the four-day match competition starting today.
