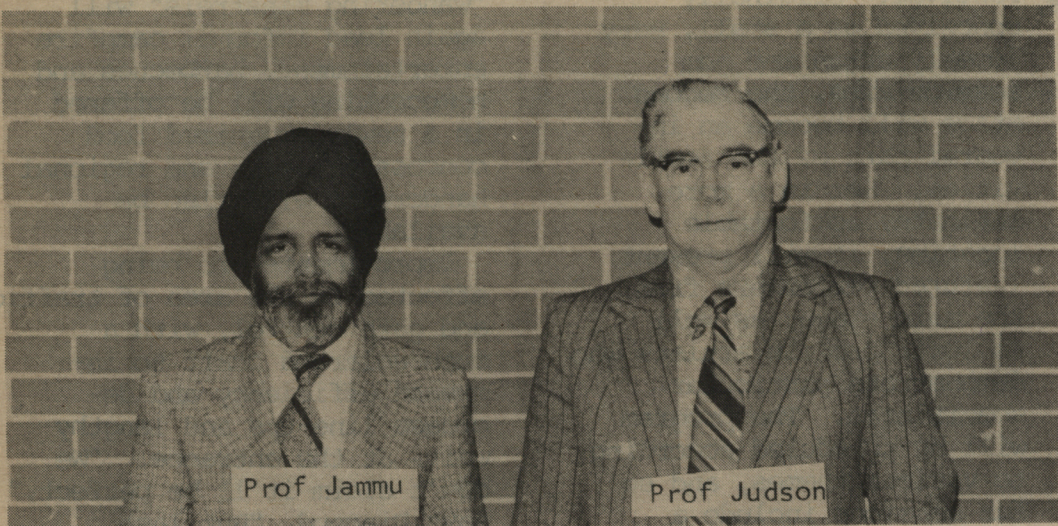

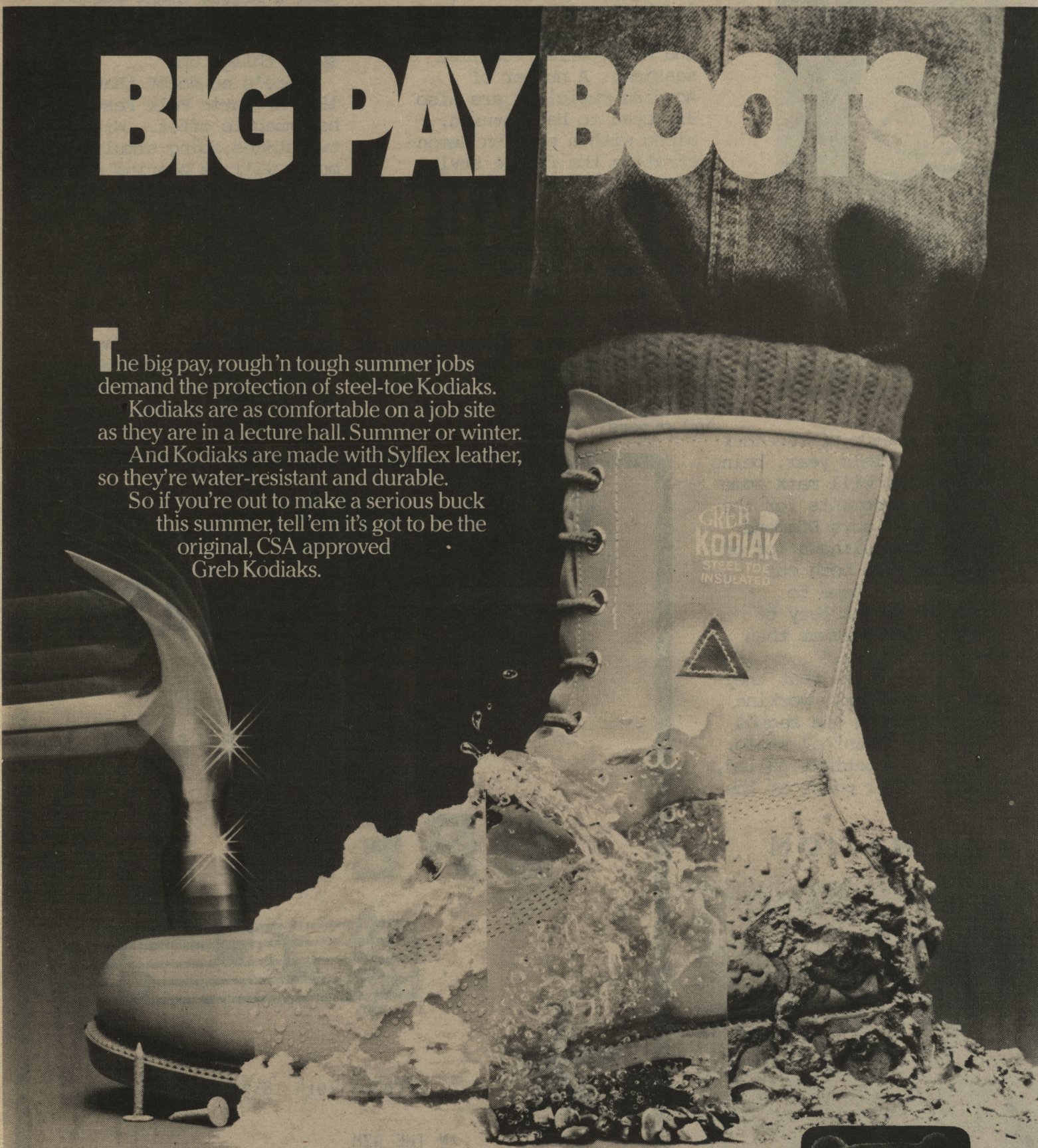
OUR TWO FOREIGN STUDENT ADVISORS

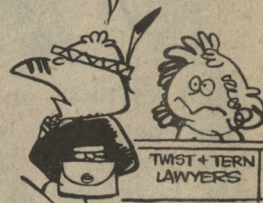

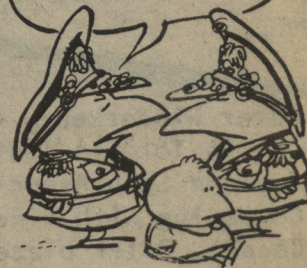
