Moths in Carpets

CURRIED SALMON PATTIES

These patties are quite delicate, yet they have plenty of flavor. We serve a suitable sauce (such as a cream sauce with added chopped hard-cooked egg or well-drained pickle) or we have a creamed vegetable that is generously sauced, to accompany the patties.

Yield—6 servings. 3 cups mashed potatoes, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/4 teaspoon pepper, 1 teaspoon curry powder, 2 tablespoons finely chopped onion, 1 tablespoon chopped parsley, 1 egg, slightly beaten, 1 can (approximately 1 pound) salmon.

How Can I...

Q. How can I make a cleaner for brass?

A. Use a paste made of vinegar and salt. Rub the article well with this mixture and let it stand for five minutes. Then wash each piece with hot water and soap suds. Polish with a soft, dry cloth. It may be necessary to make several applications.

Q. How can I make mashed potatoes fluffy?

A. Add a teaspoon of baking powder to potatoes while they are being mashed, and it will make them light and fluffy.

Q. How can I remove spots and stains from a taffeta dress?

A. Try using a little fuller's earth. Rub it on and let stand for an hour or so; then brush off.
