Browne Planning To Remain Out Of Federal Field

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP) — Former solicitor-general William J. Browne has reaffirmed his decision to remain in provincial politics and not run in St. John's West federal by-election.

In an interview here, Mr. Browne said he would continue as a member of the Newfoundland legislature in the St. John's East-Enderby by-election. The seat was created in a provincial redistribution last spring.
