Receipts this week were: 1,849 cattle, 2,925 calves, 1,048 hogs and 165 sheep and lambs. Last week cattle receipts were 1,862.
Choice steers sold at 25.50-25.60, good to choice 24.75-25.50, medium 22.25-24.50 and common 15.75-22.25.
Medium heifers were 20.25-22.60 and common 12-21.50.
Good cows were 17-19.25, medium 16-17.25, common 14.50-16.25 and canners and cutters 8-14.50.
Good bulls sold at 19.50-21 and common 12.50-19.50.
