[The following piquant and felicitous lines, from the pen of La d Macaulay, are not to be found in any compilation of his poems. They are appended to a letter, written his father in 1826, S. G. C.]

If thou wouldst view one more than man, and less Made up of mean and great, of foul and fair, Stop here; and weep and laugh and curse and bless, And spurn and worship,—for thou seest Voltaire.

That flashing eye blasted the conqueror's spear, The monarch's sceptre and the Jesuit's beads; And every wrinkle in that haggard sneer Hath been the gave of Dynasties and Creeds. In very wantonness of childish mirth, He puffed bastiles, and thrones and shrines away, Insulted Heaven and liberated Earth. Was it for good or evil? Who shall say?
