

### Debate Pensions For Widows of Clergy

KINGSTON, Ont. (CP) — An Anglican archdeacon, maintaining that "a widow is a woman" whether she be the widow of a bishop or a parson, has called for equal pensions for the widows of all Anglican clergymen.

Ven. D. S. Catchpole of Kootenay, B.C., attending the annual meeting of the executive council of the Anglican Church of Canada, introduced a resolution, Saturday asking for \$960 a year for all widows instead of the \$720 now paid to widows of clergy below the rank of bishop.

"It is an invidious distinction," he said, "Clergymen pay just as much into the fund as bishops."

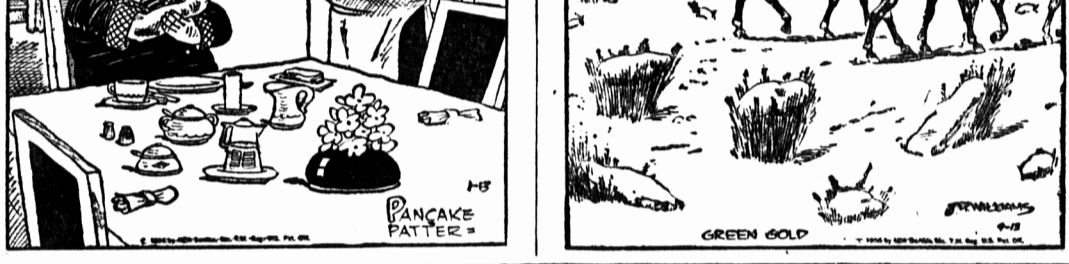
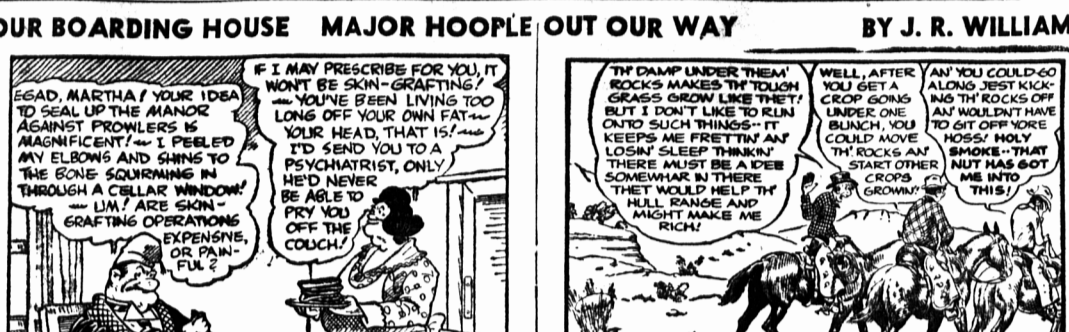
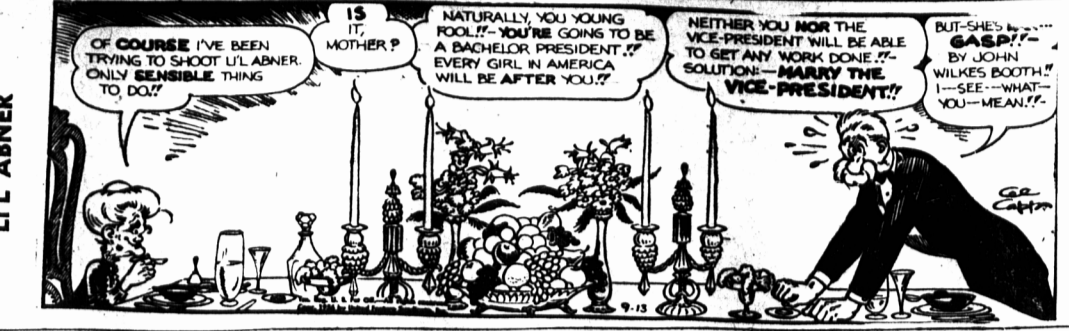

The bidding:

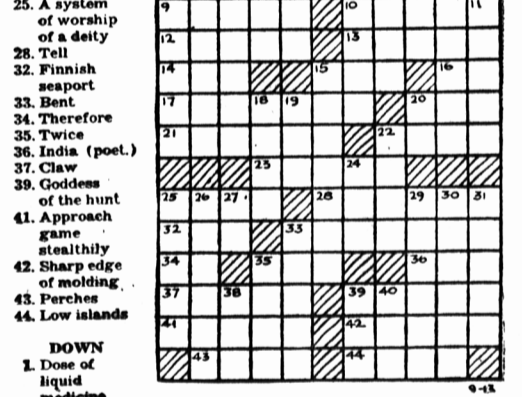
Opening lead—nine of diamonds.

The responding hand, in order to raise an opening one spade bid to three spades is expected to have at least four trumps and 13 to 15 points. In most cases high cards comprise nearly the entire point count, but hands with less in high cards may also justify the jump bid when there are sufficient distributional advantages. South, with 18 high card points, correctly bid for the slam, merely stopping to check for aces by making use of the Blackwood convention.

West opened the nine of diamonds, which declarer won in his own hand. He led a low spade to dummy's jack. West playing the deuce, and East showing out.

### Workshop Patterns

Trivets are in wide use as wall decorations as well as the traditional use of protecting the dining table from hot dishes. There are five designs on one large pattern, including a platter-size trivet. The two wall motifs illustrated are also on the pattern in actual size.

With this pattern there is no laborious tracing of the saw lines. You just lay the pattern on the wood that is to be sawed, go over it with a warm iron and the complete design is transferred to the wood. This pattern can be used on both new wood and painted surfaces.
