Murder in Alaska.

SEATTLE, Wash., April 16.—The steamer Cottage City, from Skaguay, brings news of the killing of two miners at Kalkwan, Alaska, by Chitkat Indians, for cutting their names on totem poles in an Indian graveyard, and otherwise disfiguring them. The miners were Sidney Fance, an Englishman, and Chris Erickson, a Swede.

The same vessel also brings news of the raising of the City of Topeka in Wrangel fathoms. She was temporarily repaired, and sailed to Jonson. It was thought that a portion of the cargo could be saved, but it proved to be a total loss. The vessel is expected here on Saturday.

We paid \$1,268 for British immigrants and \$14,880 for Continentals last year!

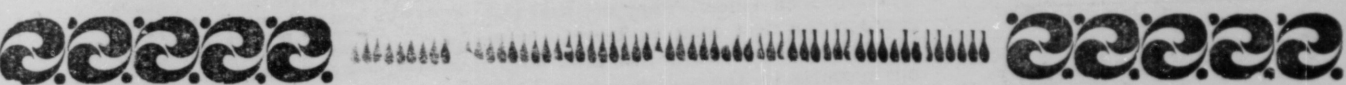

A By-law for levying and specifying the rate of assessment on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown for general Civic purposes under Statute 51 Victoria, Chapter 12.

Be it enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:—
1st. The rate of assessment on Real Estate for general Civic purposes under said Statute, for the year commencing the first day of January, A D 1899, and ending the thirty-first day of December, A D 1899, is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of one per cent on every dollar of the value of Real Estate, as assessed by the Assessors of the said City of Charlottetown in the General Assessment Book and Valuation Roll of all Real Estate and Personal Property liable to taxation in said City, and of all persons liable to pay Poll Tax therein, made and duly returned by them on the twenty-third day of March, A D 1899.
2nd. The rate of assessment on Personal Property for such general Civic purposes, for the year commencing the first day of January, A D 1899, and ending the thirty-first day of December, A D 1899, is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of seven-eighths of one per cent on every dollar of the value of Personal Property as assessed by the Assessors of the said City in the said General Assessment Book and Valuation Roll, made and duly returned by them as aforesaid.
