Nurses In N. B. Consider New Training Plan

SAINT JOHN (CP) — Taking a long step toward major changes in training of nurses in the Province, the New Brunswick Association of Registered Nurses, meeting in a special session here Thursday afternoon, unanimously adopted the report of the committee of nursing education.

Chairman of the committee, Miss Katherine McLagan of Fredericton, read the report which had been prepared after a study, by the committee, of the Russell Report recommendations.

The report recommended that independent nursing schools be established and, if possible, be in operation by September, 1957, and pointed out that the recommendation referred to two existing schools—one religious and one secular.

It gave the council of the association power to appoint a special committee and outlined terms of reference for such a committee, with authority to explore and discuss the possibility of making such arrangements with two existing schools; authority to commit them selves to such a demonstration, and authority to explore or give leadership to the exploring of possible avenues of financial support for such a demonstration.

The report also recommended that the association encourage the University of New Brunswick to take action necessary for the establishment of such a nursing education program.

In a short discussion period before the vote questions were asked concerning the definition of an "independent board," and fully responsible affiliation, and fully responsible for the financing and operation of the school. From such a school, she explained, students would enter hospital schools for certain studies necessary to their education and not dependent upon the needs of the hospital.

To a question concerning the financing of such a school, Miss McLagan replied that one purpose of the demonstration school would be to explore the possibilities of financing. Six such schools are in operation in Canada, and their system had been studied and would receive further study.
