Diefenbaker Asks For National Unity

QUEBEC (CP) — Prime Minister Diefenbaker said Saturday everyone must co-operate if Canada is to have true national unity.

Mr. Diefenbaker made two speeches during a brief visit to Quebec to inaugurate a new \$6,000,000 maritime terminal.

The prime minister stressed unity in an address to the chamber of commerce. He spoke in English, after a few opening words in French.

A true Canadian unity cannot be built without the help of all citizens, he said. Quebec, like every other province, was working to realize the promises of Confederation.

Differences which existed must be approached with good will and a spirit of compromise.

SEES GREAT FUTURE
 Mr. Diefenbaker said that while

Quebec has made tremendous strides recently, her future still holds greater promise.

During the past 10 years, he said, Quebec has become one of the greatest iron-ore centres in North America and in the world. Quebec also provided more than half of Canada's pulp and paper.

Celebrations to mark Canada's centenary in 1967 must have a national character, he said, and there must be co-operation between Ottawa and the provincial governments.

These celebrations would recall work of the past and point with hope to the future.

STRESSES IMPORTANCE
 During inauguration ceremonies at the new Champlain Maritime Terminal, Mr. Diefenbaker stressed the importance of the shipping industry in Canada's economy.

"Maritime shipping, because it is the most economical means of transport, is of the most vital importance for our industry and trade as our exports to the world markets now are facing their greatest competition ever," he said.

It was appropriate the new terminal should be named after the founder of New France who, more than 300 years ago, perceived the importance of commerce in this area.
