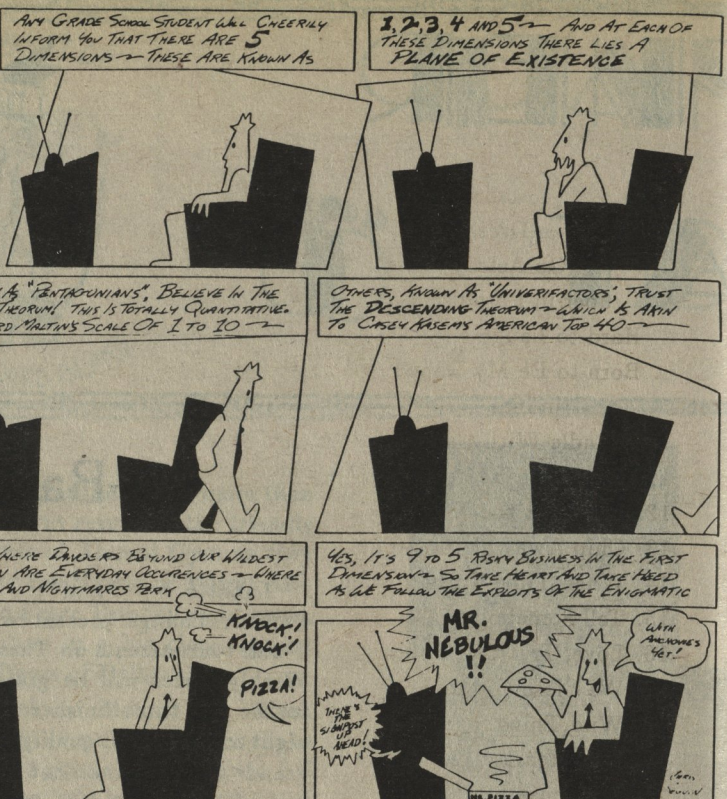


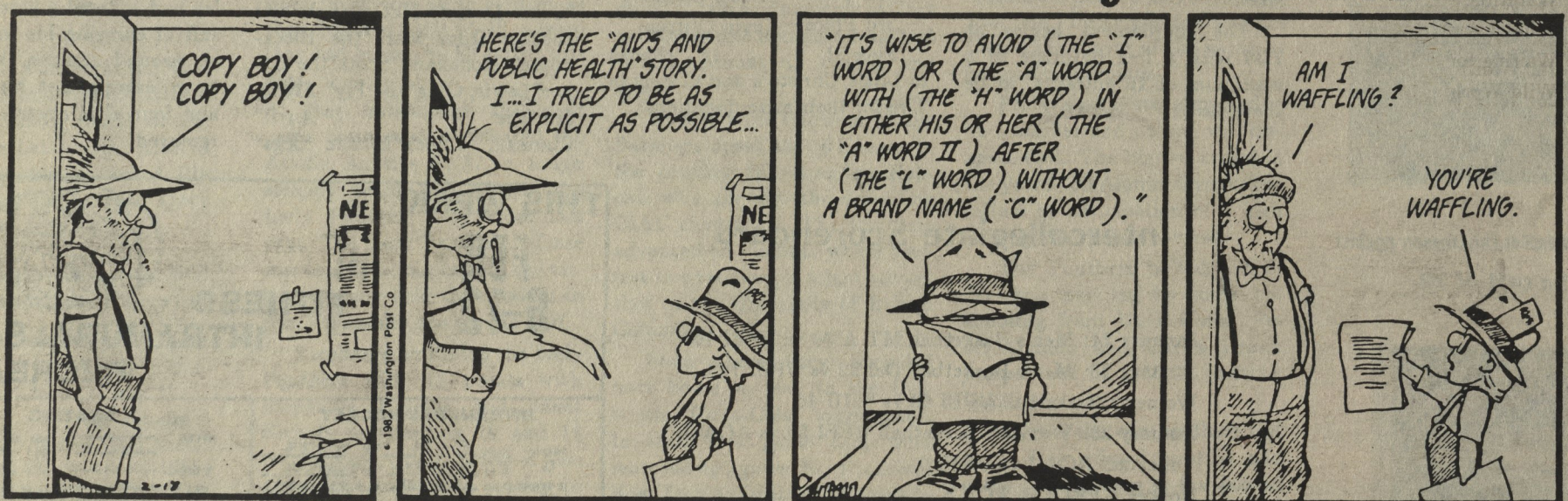

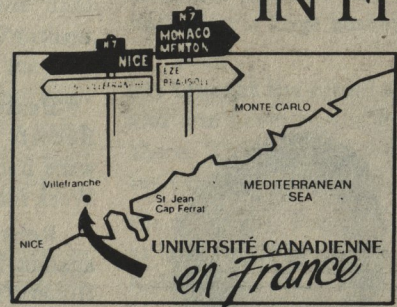

Students can enjoy a unique opportunity to earn university credits toward a Canadian B.A. while studying in the south of France. With the campus close to Nice, the Université canadienne en France offers two programmes.
