

New Party Is Formed

MONTREAL (CP) — A new political party has been formed in the Eastern Townships community of Abercorn, 80 miles from Montreal. Its name is WISDOM.

The acronym denotes Worth-while Ideas Safeguard Democracy for Man, says its creator, N. E. Atkinson, operator of a wholesale novelty business on the Vermont border.

He says he was moved to organize a new party because of "continual bickering between our leading political parties over the past few years."

Four prospective candidates have offered themselves for election, he says, one each in Nova Scotia, Ontario, Alberta and British Columbia, but "I can't name them yet. Just in case any of them wants to drop out."

Mr. Atkinson said the first formal party meeting may be held early in 1967 in Nova Scotia. One of its policy planks would be the sale of Canadian water to the United States and use of the revenue obtained to reduce income taxes.

U.S. Steel Sets Record For Year

CLEVELAND, Ohio (AP)—Steel Magazine says December will not be a record month, but it will be good enough to push this year's steel output to an all-time high.

The magazine, says November production brought the 11-month total to 123,690,000 net tons, 7,300,000 tons off the record 131,000,000 poured during 1965.

"December output will easily exceed 7,000,000 tons," the magazine says.

It estimates 2,500,000 tons of ingots and castings were produced last week, a slight decline from previous weeks' production.

The magazine says reports from mills indicate that orders from the automobile industry for January delivery vary from steady to 15 per cent below a month ago.

Railways remain strong buyers, Steel says. Their modernization programs will continue into next year, demanding specialties such as wheels, axles and rails.

Steel's composite price on No. 1 heavy melting scrap, reflecting light buying in the U.S. midwest, slipped 34 cents last week to \$28.33 a gross ton.

Starvation Top Problem, Is Claim

AYLMER, Ont. (CP) — The most dangerous problem facing the world today is self-starvation, says T. C. Douglas, New Democratic Party leader.

"One and one-half billion people will not live on the verge of starvation forever. And in the long run it is better to feed them than fight them."

He told the Rotary Club here: "The tragedy of the last 20 years is that the rich have gotten richer and the poor have gotten poorer."

"The hydrogen bomb is no danger. Atomic and nuclear energies are not a menace. They are not evil."

"The real question is whether or not agriculture can be organized in such a way to meet the needs and fill the bellies of the ever expanding population."

"We are producing less food per capita in the world today than we were in 1939—before the last great war."

Canada, he added, has created an economic jungle in which the best organized get the best share.

"We've got to start thinking about more equitable distribution of national income."

"We are never going to be able to get the farmer his fair share of the income unless we get national marketing and international marketing agreements."

Rail Employees Show Decline

OTTAWA (CP) — Employee strength in both of Canada's major railways declined sharply between 1956 and 1965, the Commons was told in a government return.

The return broke down CNE and CPR employees into five categories. The totals were down in all except the professional and technical group, which rose sharply.

On the publicly-owned CNE, the strength of this group more than doubled to 3,003 in 1965 from 1,490 in 1956. The same group almost tripled on the CPR—to 1,584 from 552.

Managerial and supervisory staff declined slightly on both lines. It went to 4,764 from 4,957 on the CNE and to 3,017 from 3,494 on the CPR.

The total CNE decline was to 85,357 from 116,324. The CPR totals were 58,456 and 84,924.

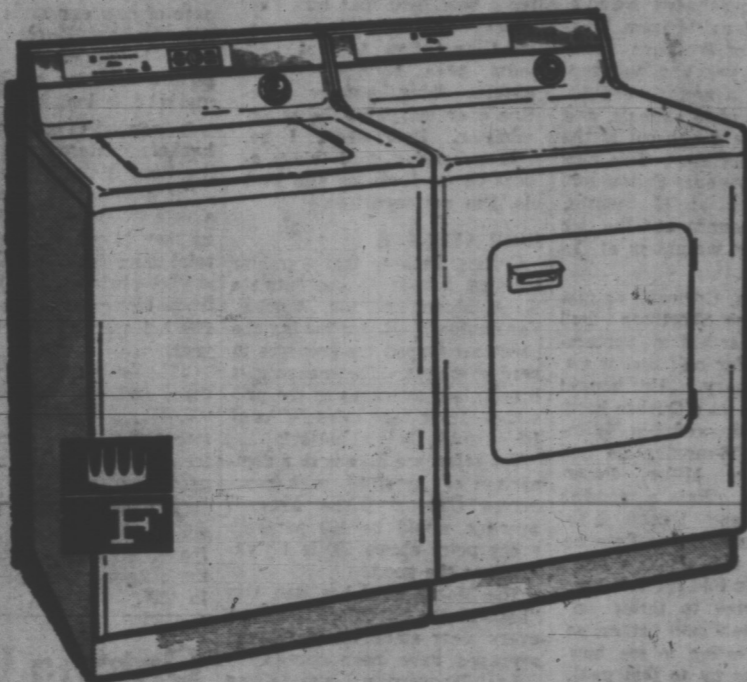

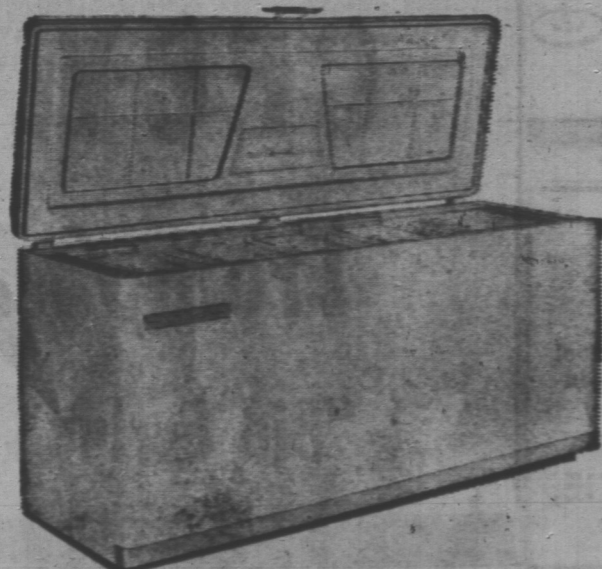

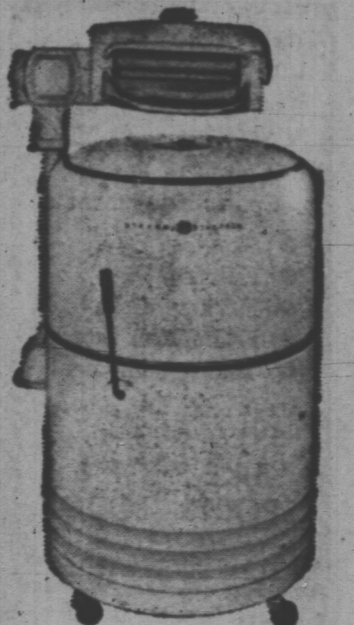
