5 c. meat stock; or 2 (10 1/4 oz.) cans condensed beef broth and 1 1/2 can-measure water; or 1 qt. water and 3 tsp. beef bouillon powder

RHUBARB - GOOSEBERRY COMPOTE
1 1/2 lb. tender pink rhubarb
1 c. sugar
1/4 c. boiling water
1/2 c. canned gooseberries
1 c. heavy cream, whipped and sweetened

SWISS HERB TART
1 peeled large onion, sliced
2 small leeks, chopped
6 thin slices bacon, in small squares
1/2 tsp. fresh chives
1/2 tsp. fresh chervil
1/2 tsp. fresh parsley
1/2 tsp. fresh basil, chopped
2 tsp. butter
4 eggs
1 1/2 c. light cream or half 'n' half
1/4 tsp. salt
1-16 tsp. cayenne
1 c. grated Gruyere cheese

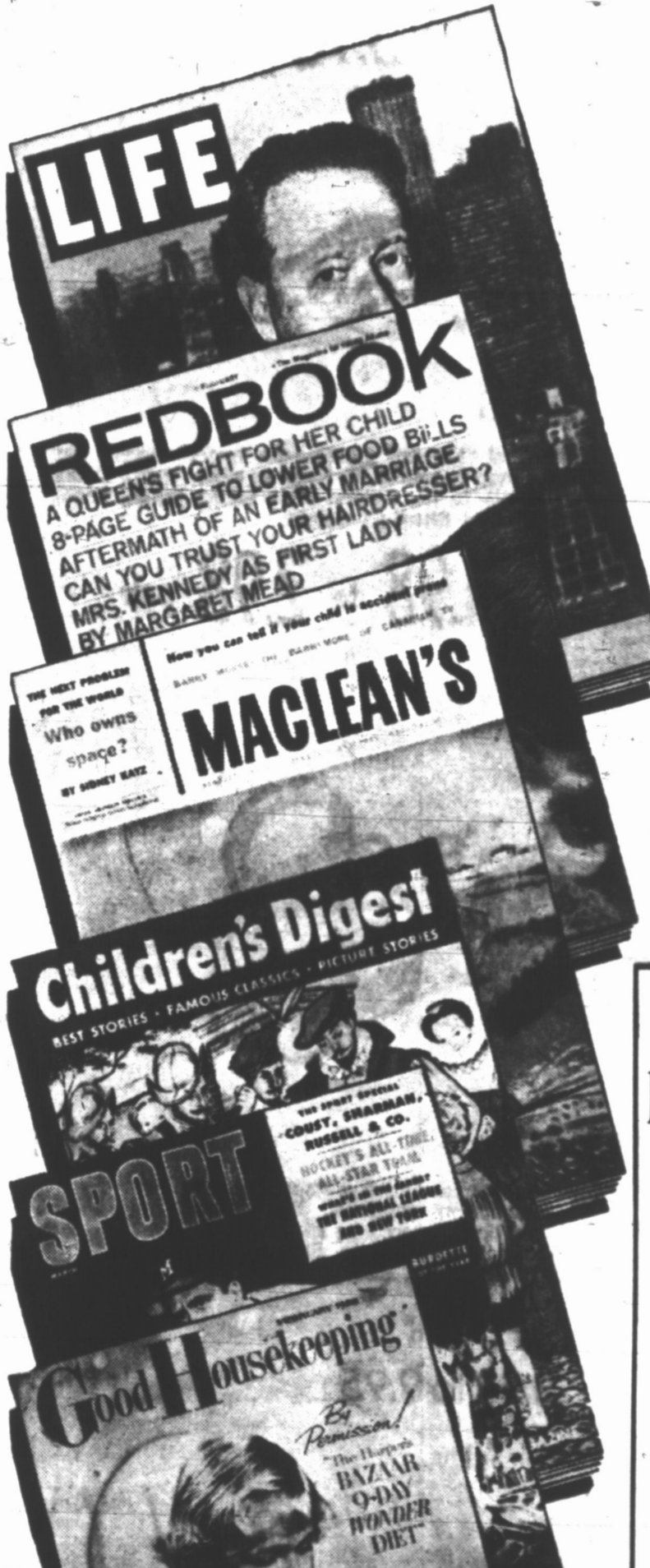
