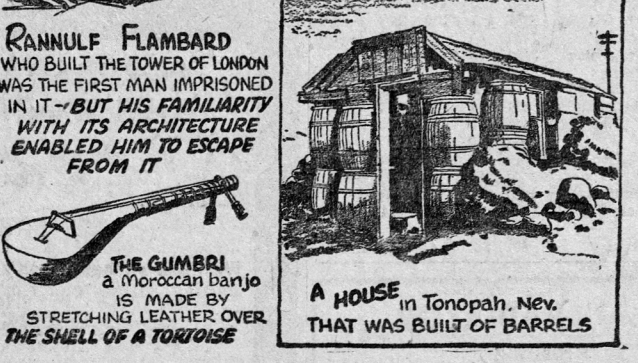

When partnership bidding goes 1♠, 1NT, 2NT, what is the meaning of the two notrump rebid by the opening bidder? The logical answer must be that the opening bidder is strongly trying for game and has 17, 18 or 19 points.

This is because responder represents 6 to 9 points by his notrump bid. Therefore, the opener (with even 19 points) cannot jump to three notrump for fear responder has only 6 points, nor can the opener pass with, say 17 points) for fear responder has 9 points. The desirable total for game is 26 points.

Yet, South missed his opportunity to make the contract. If he had had the courage to win East's six hearts return with the ace at trick three, crashing dummy's king at the same time, he would have made nine tricks.

Nor can this be called an unreasonable play, extravagant though it might seem to expend an ace and king on the same trick. The important issue was to make nine tricks, and this could be done only if three spade tricks could be established.

Another spade lead from the South hand was required to build up dummy's long suit, and South's only remaining entry—the ace of hearts—should have been used for that purpose.

**Sees Changes For Newspapers**

TOKYO (Reuters)—Transmission and reproduction of newspaper text at astronomical speed was envisaged in a report presented Saturday at the 11th congress of the International Publishers' Federation.

The report, prepared by Robert Holmberg, managing director of Information of Copenhagen, was presented by Oria Rode, general manager of the Danish newspaper Politiken.

It recommended the establishment of an international technical institute to study new developments in electronics and their application to newspaper production and asked whether newspapers should keep the ordinary printing method and lose the race, or fight for the right to communicate news through the new method.

The report said an American electronic system has made it possible to transmit 10,000 letters a second to newspapers for reproduction. A variation of the method allowed transmission direct to the printing plate for simultaneous printing.

**Ship Handed Over To Navy**

MONTREAL (CP)—HMCS Restigouche, first of a planned series of Canadian destroyer escorts, was formally handed over Saturday to the navy by the builders, Canadian Vickers Ltd.

The commissioning ceremonies were completed nearly three years after the ship was launched. Misfortune has plagued the Restigouche, the most recent setback occurring last November when the 2,900-ton vessel was in collision with a merchantman in the St. Lawrence River.

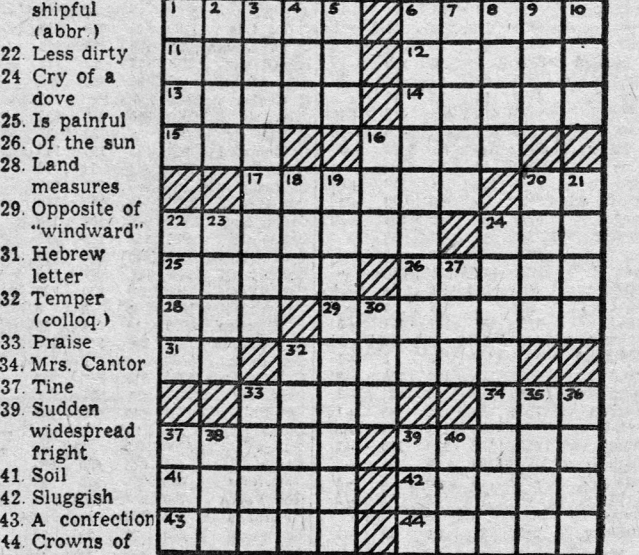
