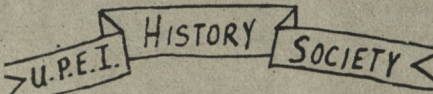


HISTORY SOCIETY

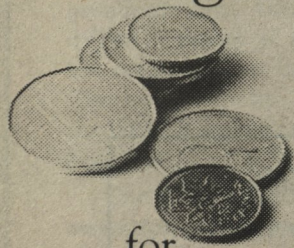

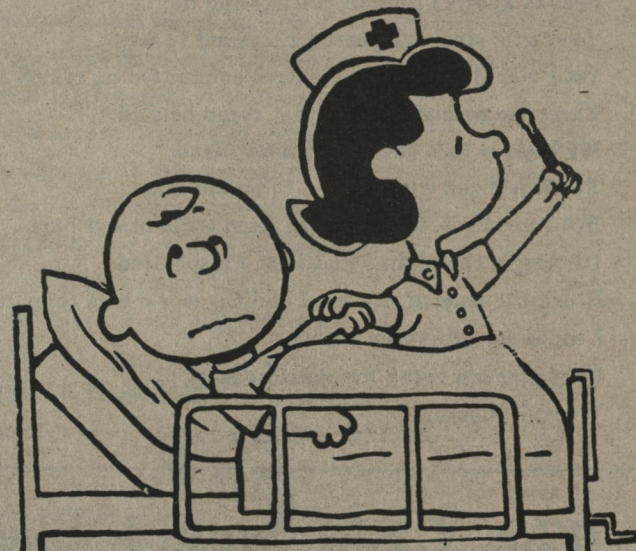
