

Flu Spreading In Great Britain

LONDON (Reuters) — Influenza appeared to be spreading in Britain Tuesday as the first supplies of vaccine went to hospitals.

Doctors and nurses began receiving the first of 85,000 inoculations designed to keep key health workers on their feet.

As flu kept miners home, reports said Welsh coal production dropped by almost 285,000 tons last week.

London schools reported about 20 per cent of pupils out with flu. In Windsor, all 18 schools were closed.

Coventry said a third of its school children were sick — along with half its telephone employees.

One big-name sufferer was Lt.-commander of Jordan's Arab Legion.

Eighteen of the 22 boys who make up part of the Westminster Abbey choir were sick on the eve of the memorial service for the late King Haakon VII of Norway.

Criminal Libel Case Is Mistrial

LOS ANGELES (AP) — The Confidential magazine criminal libel conspiracy case ended in a mistrial Tuesday when the jury reported it was unable to agree on a verdict.

Foreman Fred L. McCulley told Judge Herbert V. Walker the jury was split 7 to 5. He did not reveal the nature of the division.

Judge Walker asked McCulley: "Do you feel there is any chance of reaching a verdict with further deliberation?"

"I do not," McCulley replied.
