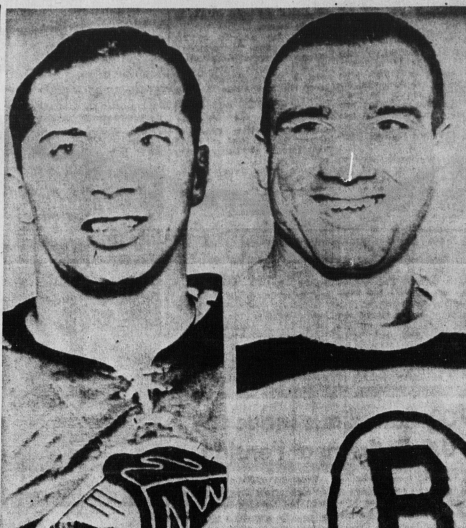

The home run, although tantamount to a hit in recent years, is still the No. 1 requisite of the fans. A tight, well-pitched game, in which the ball, stolen base and hit-and-run are featured, may best exemplify the game.
