New Advance On N.Y. Stock Market

NEW YORK, July 1 - (AP) - The stock market today staged another advance that sent it up to its fifth straight high for 1952. An exceptionally broad list of stocks was traded, and support for the advance came from key stocks in major groups.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks advanced 40 cents at \$107.50. That's a 1952 high and the best in more than 22 years. Today's market performed well with participation of leaders from steels, motors, rails, rubbers, non-ferrous metals, oils, aircrafts, and radio-television issues.

Railroads faltered on several occasions, and at the close they were up only 10 cents as measured by the AP average. Utilities held steady.

U.S. Steel gained 1/4 at 40 1/4, and other leaders were unchanged to slightly higher.

The list with 1,125 individual issues was the broadest since mid-April. A total of 66 highs and only 9 lows for the years were touched during the session.

Volume came to 1,450,000 shares, highest since early June. Higher were General Motors up 3/4 at 58 1/2, Goodrich 1 1/2 at 72 1/2, Southern Pacific 1 at 84 1/4, Standard Oil (NJ) 1 at 82, Johns-Manville 1 1/4 at 76 1/2, Cities Service 1 1/4 at 107 1/2, Philco 1 at 33 1/2, Anaconda Copper 1 at 46, Kennecott Copper 1 1/4 at 79 1/2, and Alaska-Juneau Gold 1/4 at 3.
