A spokesman for the department of public works said here Wednesday that the bridge was the property of the Prince Edward Island department of highways. It will be up to the provincial government to determine the fate of the structure.

The Hillside bridge has been replaced by a new one on the route of the Trans-Canada Highway on P.E.I. But such structures are regarded as provincial property, although the federal government makes a financial contribution to the building of the Trans Canada Highway and its bridges in each province.
